In the matter of the acceptance of the deed of Arthur Gorham for a Road Right-of-Way.

Now at this time is presented to the Court the deed of Arthur Gorham to the following described property, to-wit: A strip of land 20 feet wide the South and West side of which is described as follows:--beginning at a point the South line of Section 16, Twp 6, S. R. 38, E.W.M. 414 feet, thence North 0 deg. 17 min. West 1000 feet, thence North 1 deg. 2 min West 320 feet to the Northwest corner to the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter Section 16, TWP 6 SR 38 E.W.M. all in Union County, Oregon.

It is therefore, CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said deed be and the same is hereby accepted and the lands described therein be and the same are hereby declared to be a public highway of Union County.

In the matter of the acceptance of the Provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Act.

Now at this time, it appearing to the Court that Union County has a number of men in its employ working upon the County Roads and engaged in operating road machinery and that said men are likely to be injured at any time in the performance of their work, and that it would be for the best interests of the County, as well as its employees, to accept the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation act,

It is therefore, CONSIDERED and ORDERED that this Court does here now elect to contribute to the State Industrial Accident Fund under the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Law.

Thereupon it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned until Tuesday, April 26th, 1921, at 9:00 o'clock A.M.
