THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH, That I, Leentje Mullenburg, a widow
and his-wife, for the consideration of _____
_____ DOLLARS,

to me paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

All that part of the property of Leentje Mullenburg, in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3 T 3 SR 38 EWM of the Island City-Cove Highway as surveyed and staked across said property and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the north boundary line of Section 3 T 3 SR 38 EWM at 30 feet left of station 14/50 said point being 1395 feet east of the 1/4 section corner common to section 34 T 2 SR 38 EWM and section 3 T 3 SR 38 EWM thence south 0 degrees 26' west a distance of 1013.7 feet; thence on a 256.5 foot radius curve to the left a distance of 403.9 feet to a point 30 feet left of station 29/70.2 P.T. thence south 89 degrees 36' west a distance of 275 feet; thence north 1 degree 12' east a distance of 1275.7 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel of land contains 0.59 acres more or less.

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made, the Journal of the last day's proceedings was read, approved, and is here now signed.

Whereupon the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of the deed of Leentje Muilenburg for a right-of-way for the Island City-Cove Road.

Now at this time is presented to the Court the deed of Leentje Muilenburg for a right-of-way for the Island City-Cove Road across lands owned by the said Leentje Muilenburg, and it appearing to the Court that it is necessary for Union County to acquire said right-of-way for use in the construction of said road,

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said deed be accepted and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the Road Bond Fund in favor of said Leentje Muilenburg in the sum of \$100.00 in payment for said deed.

In the matter of the application of Jessie Woodell for relief.

Now at this time this matter comes on to be heard upon the application of Jessie Woodell for County Aid and it appearing to the Court from said application that the husband of the said Jessie Woodell is confined in the State Penitentiary at Salem, Oregon, and that she has three small children to care for; that she has no relatives or friends who are able or willing to assist her; and that by reason of the age of said children, she is unable to leave home for the purpose of earning a livelihood and the Court having considered said petition, and being fully advised in the premises,

It is CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said petition be allowed and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the general fund of the County monthly in the sum of \$20.00 in favor of said Jessie Woodell until further orders of this Court.

In the matter of the application of Fritz Hoffman for a Dance Hall Permit.

Now at this time is presented to the Court the application of Fritz Hoffman for a license to conduct a public dance hall in Mill Canyon south of La Grande, Oregon, and it appearing to the Court that the applicant is a person of good moral character and has deposited with the County Clerk the fee required by law for said license,

It is hereby ORDERED that the County Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to issue a license to the said Fritz Hoffman to conduct a dance hall with a floor space of 2000 square feet in Mill Canyon south of La Grande, Oregon, during the year of 1924.
