That I am a resident of Union County, Oregon, and have been such a resident for more than years lastpast; that I waw well acquainted with Jacob P. DeLong, Iong a resident of Union County, Oregon, in his lifetime, and said Jacob P. DeLong was sometimes known as J.P.DeLong, and that I know that J.P.DeLong, who, as grantee, received the title to the SW2 of Section 18, Township 2 South of Range 39, E.W.M., from S.O.Johnson and Martha L. Johnson, his wife, by deed dated April 4, 1887, recorded in Book K of Union County, Oregon, Deed Records, page 597, was one and the same person who, as J.P.DeLong, thus signed and acknowledged that certain warranty deed dated March 8, 1898, recorded Book Z of Deeds, page 585, recordsof Union County, Oregon, to J.J.Conley, wherein the above described land was conveyed to said Conley, and said grantor named and described in the body of the deed as J.P.Long.

That I was likewise well and personally acquainted with Benjamin Brown, for many years a resident of Union County, Oregon, one of the grantees in that certain deed dated October 28, 1885, recorded in UnionCounty, Oregon, Deed Records, Book K, at page 198, and that I know that said Benjamin Brownwas one and the same person as Ben Brown, who, with his wife Frances Brown, signed that certain deed dated October 18, 1886, recorded in Union County, Oregon, Deed Records, Book K, at page 201, as Ben Brown, and executed and acknowledged the same as Benjamin Brown.
