Becker, his wife, to lands in the $N\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{4}$ and the $N\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}$ and the $S\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Tp 2 SR 40 EWM for use as a right-of-way for the Alicel-Lower Cove Market Road, and it appearing to the Court that it is necessary for Union County to acquire said lands for use in the construction of said road as located and approved by the State Highway Commission,

Now at this time it is ORDERED THAT the County Treasurer be and she is hereby authorized to transfer moneys from any fund of the County having sufficient moneys to any other fund of the County not having sufficient moneys to pay duly authorized warrants issued on said fund when it shall appear to her that such transfers are necessary, and that said money so transferred be repaid whenever the fund so relieved by the transfer has sufficient monies to its credit for that purpose.
