Now at this time is presented to the Court two deeds signed by Mrs. W. M. Evans to tracts of land containing .9 and .66 acres respectively, in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Twp 2 S, R 38 EWM, as rights-of-way for the Mount Glenn Market Road, and it appearing to the Court that it is necessary for Union County to acquire said lands for use in the construction of said road,

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said Deeds be and the same are hereby accepted.

In the matter of the application of Mrs. Ray McCarroll for dependent Mother's Assistance.

It is CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said application be allowed and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the General Fund of the County in favor of Hans Jensen in the sum of \$10.00 per month until further orders.
