

THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH, That Elizabeth A. Galloway, a widow

and her his wife, for the consideration of

to her paid, ha<sup>s</sup> bargained and sold, and by these presents do<sup>es</sup> bargain, sell and con-

vey unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

All that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, T 1 N, R 39 EWM,  
within a strip of land 60 feet in width being 30 feet on each side of the  
center line of the proposed county road petitioned for by J. F. T.  
Galloway, et al., said parcel of land being more particularly described  
as follows:

Beginning at a point designated as station 0/28.0 said station being the intersection of said center line with the present county road and approximately 2702.3 feet north and 1156.8 feet east of the center of section 3, T 1 N, R 39 EWM, thence S 89° 00' E a distance of 216.5 feet thence on a 191.0 feet radius curve to the right a distance of 380.8 feet, thence S 25° 15' W a distance of 4.7 feet, thence on 573.0 feet radius curve to the left a distance of 199.3 feet, thence S 5° 19' W a distance of 450.3 feet, thence on a 358.1 feet radius curve to the left a distance of 351.1 feet, thence S 50° 52' E a distance of 510.3 feet, thence on a 409.3 feet, radius curve to the left a distance of 196.4 feet, thence S 78° 22' E a distance of 11.1 feet, thence on a 119.4 feet radius curve to the right a distance of 209.8 feet, thence S 22° 21' W a distance of 284.4 feet, thence on a 286.5 feet radius curve to the left a distance of 221.3 feet, thence S 21° 54' E a distance of 296.3 feet, thence on a 286.5 feet radius curve to the right a distance of 176.7 feet to the intersection of said center line with the south boundary line of Elizabeth Galloway property and approximately 16.7 feet south and 2288.5 feet east of the center of section 3, T 1 N, R 39 EWM. THURSDAY, DECEMBER 8th, 1927.

That the Eastern Oregon State Normal School has been located upon the following described property, to-wit:

A plot of ground lying on the brow of the hill bounded by Eighth Street, L Street, Hill Street and the lands of the La Grande Masonic Cemetery Association;

That in order to secure said site the city of La Grande has exchanged said lots for said Normal School Site, reserving to itself Blocks 2 and 3, Connordale for a City Park, and has petitioned for the cancellation of said taxes, and School District No. 1 and the city of La Grande authorize the cancellation in so far as their interests are affected.

Now therefore, be it RESOLVED that the taxes standing upon the records of Union County, Oregon, as due upon said lots, be and the same are hereby are remitted and cancelled and the sheriff is hereby authorized and directed to note upon the tax roll for said tax years the cancellation and remission of said taxes.
