

All that part of the property located in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of section 5 T 1 N R 40 EWM being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 30 feet left of station 28/16.4, said point being approximately 2594.6 feet south and 308.6 feet east of the quarter corner common to section 5 T 1 N R 40 EWM, and section 32 T 2 N R 40 EWM, thence north along the east boundary line of the Cricket Flat Cemetery a distance of 262.0 feet, thence south 12 deg. 19 min. E a distance of 268.2 feet, thence west a distance of 61.4 feet to the place of beginning. Said tract of land contains 0.18 acres more or less.

Now at this time this matter comes on for consideration of the application of E. B. Millard for County Aid, and it appearing to the Court that the applicant is of the age of 67 years, and that by reason of his advanced age and ill health is unable to earn a livelihood and is without funds with which to support himself, and that he has no relatives or friends who are willing or able to support him and the Court having fully considered said application and being advised in the premises,

It is CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the said E. B. Millard be granted an allowance of \$10.00 per month as County Aid until further orders of this Court, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to issue a warrant monthly as allowed herein.

In the matter of the petition of  
F. Z. Terpany for the cancellation  
of the last half of 1921 taxes.

Now at this time this matter comes on for further consideration of the application of F. Z. Terpany for the cancellation of the last half of 1921 taxes assessed against the property of the said F. Z. Terpany, within Union County, and it appearing to the Court that since the denial of said petition on November 5th, 1926, records have been found showing that said tax was actually paid but that same was not credited upon the Tax Roll by the then Sheriff,

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the County Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to draw a warrant on the General Fund of the County in the sum of \$49.44 in favor of the Sheriff of Union County, as payment of the last half of the 1921 taxes assessed against the property of the said F. Z. Terpany and the interest and penalty on said tax be and the same is hereby cancelled and the Sheriff is hereby authorized to cancel said interest and penalty upon the tax roll of the county.

Now at this time this matter comes on for consideration of the application of Margaret Earl for County Aid and it appearing to the Court from said petition that the said Margaret Earl is of the age of 62 years, and is paralyzed, and that by reason of old age and her physical condition is unable to earn a livelihood; that she has no relatives or friends who are willing or able to assist her and the Court being fully advised in the premises,

It is CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said application be allowed and that the Servewell Grocery of Elgin, Oregon, be and it is hereby authorized to furnish the said Margaret Earl with supplies to the extent of \$7.50 per month until the further orders of this Court.

Fitzgerald has filed a good and sufficient bond indemnifying the County against any loss which may arise on account of the payment of said warrant,

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the County Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw another warrant on the General Fund of the County in the sum of \$2.20 in lieu of said lost warrant.

In the matter of the application of Jesse Breshears, Sheriff, for authority to issue certificates of delinquency for 1925 taxes to private parties.
