All that part of the property located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32 T 2 N R 40 EWM within a strip of land 60 ft in width being 30 ft on each side of the center line of the Cemetery-Cricket Flat Market Road, said parcel of land being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point designated as station 85/00 said station being the intersection of said center line with the east fence line of the present county road and approximately 2301.5 south and 2642.0 ft west of the section corner common to sections 28, 29, 32 & 33 T 2 N R 40 EWM thence on a 573.0 ft radius curve to the right a distance of 178.5 ft thence N 36° 24' E a distance of 935.0 ft to station 96/13.5 said station being the intersection of said center line with the south fence line of the present County Road and approximately 1393.0 ft south and 2011.0 ft west of the section corner common to sections 28, 29, 32 & 33 T 2 N R 40 EWM.
