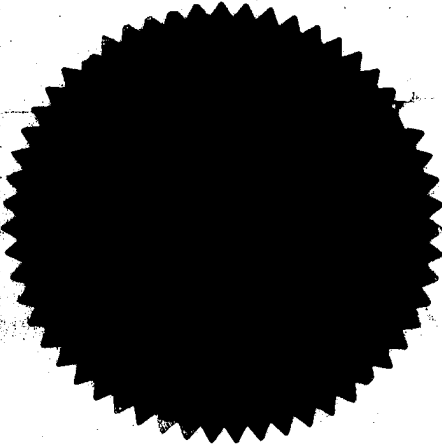

LA GRANDE, OREGON.

Know All Men by These Presents.

That we Frank R. Suydam, Frank J. Skala
 and William E. McClure duly constituted Trustees of
 La Grande Lodge No. 16, I. O. O. F. (incorporated), for and in consideration of the sum of
~~One hundred Eighty~~ and no/100 DOLLARS
 to us in hand paid, and the further Express Agreement by the Grantee, that the property conveyed
 shall be used for Cemetery purposes only, and that the same shall conform at all times to
 the Printed Rules and Regulations of said Cemetery for the care of the buried dead, and the
 grounds embraced in the said Cemetery, as promulgated by said Lodge, do hereby grant,
 set apart and convey to Union County, State
 of Oregon the following parcel of ground, to-wit:
 The Lots 1-2 and 3 of Block No. 276 of the recorded plat and survey of
 the Odd Fellows' Cemetery of La Grande, Oregon, and all right, title and interest the said La
 Grande Lodge, No. 16, I. O. O. F., may have in the said parcel of ground, excepting, always,
 that the said grantor, La Grande Lodge No. 16, I. O. O. F., and its successors, reserves the
 right to restrain the use of said parcel of ground other than for Cemetery purposes;
 to protect and regulate the lawful use and management of the Cemetery grounds most con-
 ducive to the welfare and due respect of all concerned, and arrange for the proper burial
 of the incoming dead and care of their graves, not inconsistent with legal private rights.
