THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH, That John J. Murchison  
and Mary E. Murchison his wife, for the consideration of  
Twelve and No/100 DOLLARS,

to them paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

All that parcel of land situated in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section  
27 Twp 1 South, Range 38, EMM, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 380 feet south and 1320 feet west of the center  
of Section 27 T 1S R38, EMM; thence north 8° 37' west a distance of 114  
feet; thence south 81° 23' west a distance of 95.0 feet; thence south  
8° 37' east a distance of 114 feet; thence north 81° 23' east a distance  
of 95.0 feet to the point of beginning. Said tract of land contains  
0.25 acres more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land, with its appurtenances, for county road purposes to said  
Union County and the public therein forever, and \_\_\_\_\_, the said John J. Murchison  
and Mary E. Murchison do hereby covenant to and with the said Union County

In the matter of the acceptance of a deed of John J. Murchison, et ux.

Now at this time is presented to the court the deed of John J. Murchison, et ux, conveying to Union County for road purposes 0.25 of an acre of land in the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 27, Twp 1S, Range 38, EWM, and it appearing to the Court that it is necessary for Union County to acquire said land as a part of the right-of-way of the Hunter Lane Market Road,

It is ORDERED that said deed be accepted and recorded in the deed records of Union County.

In the matter of the claim of Jack Hensley for indemnity for diseased cow slaughtered under the provisions of Section 20-408, Oregon Code.

Now at this time is presented to the court the claim of Jack Hensley for indemnity in the sum of \$15.00 for a cow slaughtered under the provisions of Section 20-408, Oregon Code, and it appearing to the court from the certificate of Sam B. Foster, Inspector in charge at the stock yards of North Portland, that said animal was slaughtered (died in truck enroute from farm to N. Portland) on March 31st, 1933, and from the affidavit of Jack Hensley, the claimant, that said animal was owned in the state the required length of time to come under the provisions of Section 20-408, Oregon Code, and it further appearing that the requirements relative to the disinfection of the stables where said animal was kept have been complied with, and no one having appeared to resist said claim,

It is CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the same be allowed, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the General Fund of the county in favor of Jack Hensley in the sum of \$7.50, said sum being one half of said claim and the amount to be paid by Union County.

In the matter of establishing a county road at Perry, Oregon.

WHEREAS, it appears that there is no county road connecting the town of Perry, Oregon, with the Old Oregon Trail State Highway, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the traveling public and more particularly the residents of Perry, are dependent upon a private road for access to said town of Perry, and

WHEREAS, it appears that public necessity requires the establishment of a county road connecting said town of Perry with the Old Oregon Trail State Highway, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED AND DECLARED that it is the intention of the County Court of Union County, Oregon, to establish a county road between the points and along the line described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of the present county road No. 371, at survey station 4/15.0, which point is the SW corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34 T 2S, R37, EWM; thence running North 55° 53' West a distance of 185.0 feet to station 6/00; thence North 79° 38' West a distance of 173.0 feet to survey station 7/73.0, which said point is on the east right of way line of the Old Oregon Trail Highway and 136.2 feet north and 323.2 feet west of the SW corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34 T 2S, R37, EWM,

said road to be 60 feet in width, or 30 feet on either side of the center line of the above described survey;

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED AND DECLARED that it is the intention of the County Court of Union County, Oregon, to establish as a part of and a connection to the above described
