THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH, That George A. Fuller
and Violet Fuller his wife, for the consideration of
One and no/100 DOLLARS,

to US paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto
the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

All that part of the property of George A. and Violet Fuller
located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5 T I N R 39 E.W.M. as surveyed
over and across said property, and being more particularly described as
Follows:

Beginning at a point 20 ft. East of Station 117437.4 said point
being approximately 1401.4 ft. South and 69.8 ft. West of the section
corner common to Sections 4 and 5 T I N R 39 E.W.M. and 32 and 33
T 2 N R 39 E.W.M., thence N3 $^{\circ}$ 40' E a distance of 821.6 ft., thence
S1 $^{\circ}$ 42' W a distance of 408.0 ft., thence S1 $^{\circ}$ 52' W a distance of 413.6 ft.,
thence West a distance of 17.0 ft. to the place of beginning, and
beginning at a point 20 ft. West of Station 124400 said point being
approximately 739.6 ft. South and 45.5 ft. West of the section corner
common to Sections 4 and 5 T I N R 39 E.W.M. and Sections 32 and 33
