RIGHT OF WAY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That The Federal Land Bank of Spokane, a corporation organized and existing under the Federal Farm Loan Act, approved July 17, 1916, with its principal place of business in the City of Spokane, County of Spokane, State of Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 Dollars (\$1.00), and other good and valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant unto UNION COUNTY, OREGON, an easement over the following described property for highway purposes, to-wit:

All that portion of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 8, Township 1 North, Range 39 East of the Willamette Meridian, lying within a strip of land 30 feet wide, being 30 feet in width on the Westerly side of the following described centerline of road survey, to-wit: Beginning at station 72+10.0 of said survey, said station being approximately 447.5 feet South and 28.8 feet East of the Northeast corner of said section, thence on the arc of a 716.3 feet radius curve right a distance of 197.7 feet; thence North 0°17' East 248.3 feet to station 76+56.0, said station being approximately 2.5 feet East of the Northeast corner of said Section, less existing road. Union County, Oregon.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said premises unto Union County, Oregon for highway purposes.


