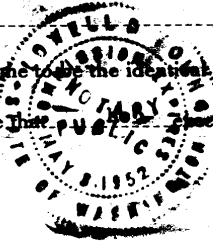

THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH, That Arthur Carl Glenn

and Pearl J. Glenn his wife, for the consideration of

Two hundred (\$200.00) dollars and no (00) cents DOLLARS,

to us paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

Parcel # 2.

A parcel of land lying in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4, and the E 1/2 and the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 13 T 1S R38 E.W.M. of Union County, Oregon.

Said parcel of land being included in a strip of land thirty (30) feet in width lying on the Easterly side of the Center Line of the Imbler-Summersville County Road as said road has been relocated and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is Engineer's Center Line Station 115+22, said point being on the quarter line 315 feet West of the East quarter corner of Sec. 13 T 1S R38 E.W.M; thence N 25°24'20"W 1459.1 ft; thence on a spiral curve left (the long cord of which bears N 25°26'35"W) 150 ft; thence on a 38197.20 radius curve left (the long cord of which bears N 25°45'30"W) 318.9 feet to Engineer's Center Line Station 144+50 opposite and thirty (30) feet distant from which Station the Easterly line of said strip of land intersects the North line of said Sec. 13.

The parcel of land to which this description applies contains 2.02 acres of which 1.48 acres lie within the existing R/W, title to which hereby is acknowledged to be in the public, and 0.54 acres lie outside of the existing R/W.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land, with its appurtenances, for county road purposes to said Union County and the public therein forever, and we, the said Arthur Carl Glenn and

Pearl J. Glenn his wife do hereby covenant to and with the said Union County that we are the owners in fee simple of said lands; that they are free from all encumbrances except
