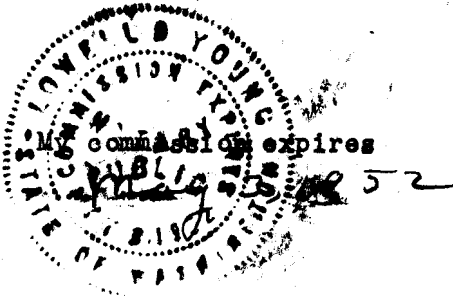

THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH, That Arthur Carl Glenn

and Pearl Q. Glenn his wife, for the consideration of

One hundred (\$100.00) dollars and no (00) cents DOLLARS,

to us paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto

the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

Parcel # 1.

A parcel of land lying in the W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 18 T 13 R39 E.W.N. of Union County, Oregon.

This said parcel being all that portion of said W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 18, included in a strip of land lying between the existing County Road and a line which is parallel to and forty (40) feet Easterly of the Center Line of the Imbler-Summersville County Road as said road has been relocated, which Center Line is described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is Engineer's Center Line Station 95+85 at which point the Southerly line of said strip of land lies at right angles to said Center Line; said point being approximately 950 feet South 585 feet East of the SW corner of Sec. 18 T 13 R39 E.W.N.; thence N 38°00' 50" W 193 ft; thence on a spiral curve right (the long cord of which bears N 36°00' 50" W) 300 ft; thence on a 1432.39 ft. radius curve right (the long cord of which bears N 39°29' 35" W) 26.03 ft; thence on a spiral curve right (the long cord of which bears N 24°58' 20" W) 300 ft; to Engineer's Center Line Station 103+84.03 equals 103+85.5; thence N 24°58' 20" W. 449.5 ft, to Engineer's Center Line Station 108+45 opposite and forty (40) feet distant from which Station the Easterly line of said strip of land intersects the Westerly line of said Sec. 18.

The parcel of land to which this description applies contains 1.2 acres, of which 0.5 acres lie within the existing R/W, title to which hereby is acknowledged to be in the public, and 0.7 acres lie outside of the existing R/W. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land, with its appurtenances, for county road purposes to said Union County

and the public therein forever, and we the said Arthur Carl Glenn and wife

Pearl Q. Glenn do hereby covenant to and with the said Union County that we are the owners in fee simple of said lands; that they are free from all encumbrances except
