It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the La Grande Evening Observer and the Eastern Oregon Review be, and they are hereby, designated as official newspapers of Union County for the year 1955.

In the matter of the application of  
Evergreen Dance Hall for Dance Hall  
License.

Now at this time, is presented to the court the application of Indian Valley Auxialary Post #4399, to conduct a dance hall near Elgin, Oregon, to be known as Evergreen Dance Hall, and it appearing to the court that said application is in due form and signed by 12 free-holders residing in the school district in which the dance hall is located and it further appearing to the court that the applicatns have filed a good and sufficient bond as required by law in the sum of \$500.00 and it further appearing to the court that the applicatns will run an orderly house,
