

practicable and to open the same a public necessity
and therefore we recommend the same to be opened.

Range (38) Thirty eight east, where the LaGrande and Coos County Road crosses the same, and running thence south (according to the U.S. Survey) about (250) two hundred and fifty rods to a rock marked (A.), thence in a southeasterly course about (2) two miles to a rock marked (B) near Farmer and McWhirter's late mill site.

where the La Grande and Cove county road
crosses the same and running thence south
(according to the U.S. survey) about two hundred
and fifty rods to a rock marked "A"

Thence in a southeasterly course about
two miles to a rock marked "B" near Palmer
& Mr. Whales old mill site.

And it appearing to the court that a good
and sufficient bond has been filed according
to law and from proofs filed herein
that due notice of the pendency of these

had been given and that all proceedings
henceforth had been regular, and in conform-
ity with law. It was ordered and adjudged
that G. A. Palms, Samuel Souder ^{and} Peter Kuhn
be and they are hereby appointed trustees and
Mr. Blaemphur ^{as} surveyor to meet at
Somerset Banks Store in La Grande and after
being duly qualified, proceed to view survey ^{and}
mark said proposed road and report the

was read the second time the report of the viewers
and surveyor heretofore appointed to view, survey
and report upon a proposed county road as
follows to wit: Beginning on a line running
North and South according to the U. S. Survey
through the center of Sec. eight-(8) of Township
Three (3) South Range Thirty-eight-(38) East-
where the La Grande and lower road cross the
same and running thence south according to
the U. S. Survey about two hundred and fifty
yards (250 rods) to a rock marked (A), thence
in a South Easterly course about two miles
to a rock marked B, near Palmers and Whirters
late Mill site,

And it appearing to the satisfaction of the
court of said Union County that the proceedings
herin have been regular and in conformity
with the statute in such cases made
and provided; And that no complaints
have been filed for damages in consequence
of the opening of said proposed road and
there appearing no remonstrance against
the location of said road.
