on said route with comparatively little expense
and we do recommend to your Hon body
to establish and cause to be opened a
County road on said route as designated
by the notes and Plat of the Survey.

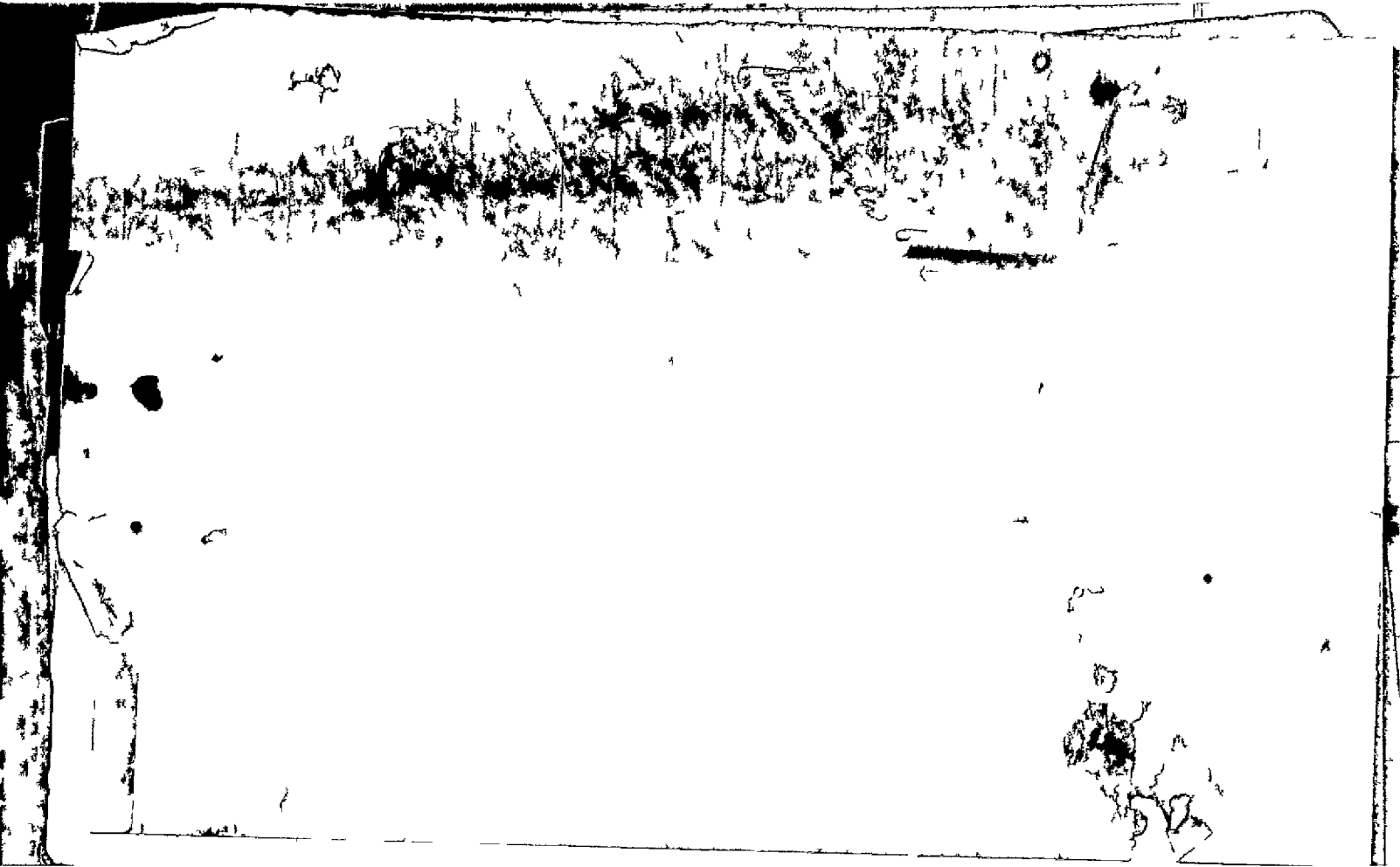
