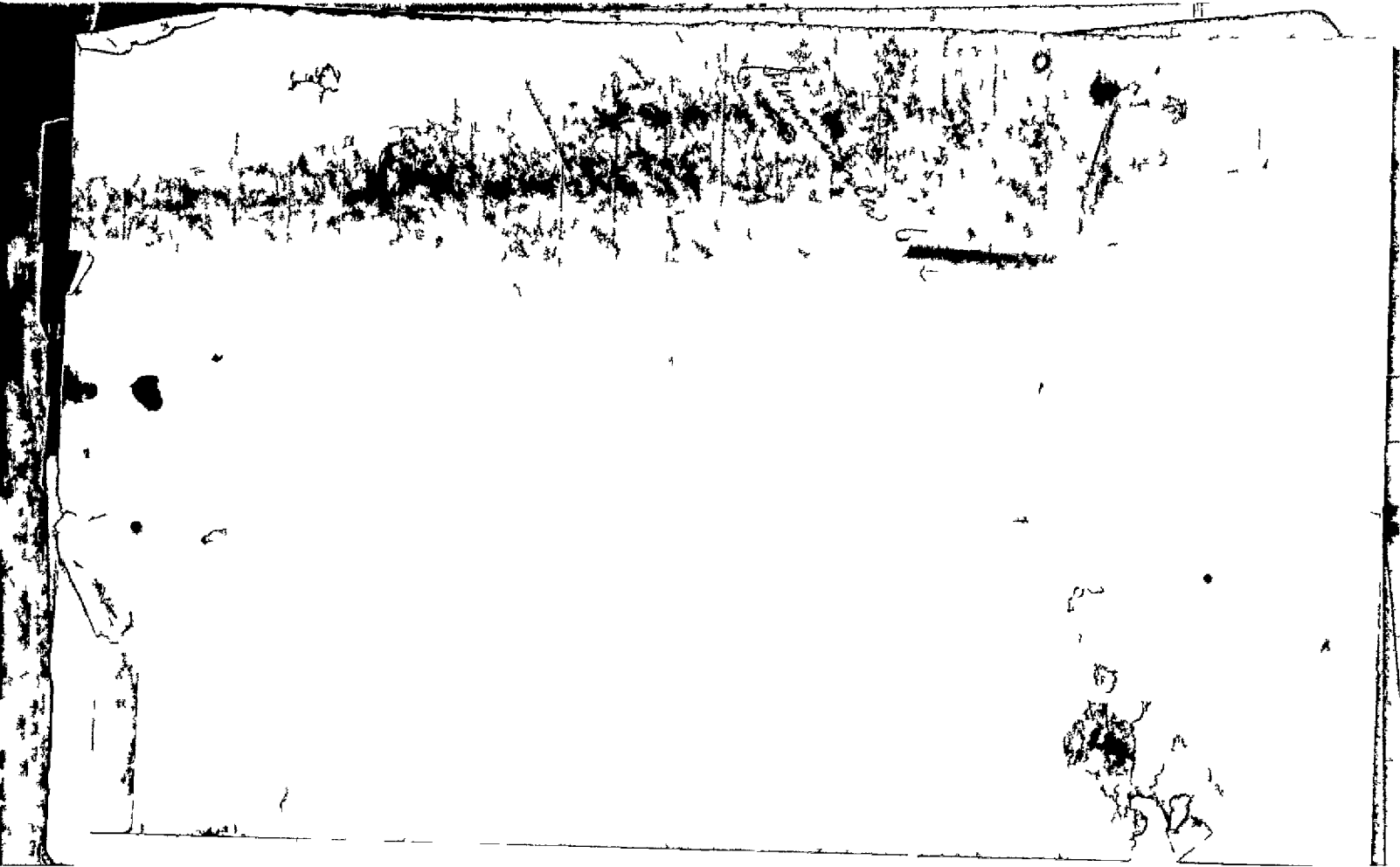

Sum of Fifty Dollars for the Term of Six Months

Now On this day was read for the Second day the report of the Viewers of the above road and there being no remonstrance to said road and it appearing from the report of said Viewers herein recorded that said road would be of public utility the report of Viewers was accepted and it is ordered that the said road be opened a width of 60 feet - Viewers Report

We the Undersigned Viewers appointed by the Hon Board of County Commissioners of Union County to View Out a road leading from LaGrande to Summerville in said County would report as follows Viz that we went on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of November 1856 as required and after being duly Qualified Commenced and continued on said work until the 23<sup>d</sup> Successively that we have Viewed out and Surveyed a road in Our judgment the nearest and most practicable between the aforesaid named points and we believe that a good road can be made in said route as designated by the notes and plat of the Survey of T. M. Cornas Subscribed and sworn to before me
