Signed this *6th* day of *Jan* A. D. 18*80*

Now the condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas, if the County Road petitioned for by *Robert Weaver* and others, and presented at the *Jan* term, 18*80*, of the County Court of said ~~Mason~~ *Union* county, commencing in the County Road near the gate about 100 yds in a North easterly direction from the residence of *E. B. Morelock* and running thence by an Easterly direction along the traveled route crossing the river on the bridge built by the County and of road work &c, thence continuing in a North easterly direction along the traveled route as nearly may be touching the corners between the farms of *Joel Weaver* & *Wm. J. Stevenson* on the West side crossing *English* & *Clarks* Creeks over the bridges and following the grade to the foot of the *Clarks* Creek hill thence over the most practicable route in the event the County road about 200 yds west of *Wald* *hills* be located and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law.

The following among other proceedings, were had, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF the location of a County

Road from near the residence of E. B. Morelock to about 100 yds West of the residence of Matt. Nickels

On this day came J. G. Weaver who presents to the Court the petition of himself and others, praying for the location and establishment of a County road as follows to-wit: Beginning on the County road about 100 yds. in a north easterly direction from the residence of E. B. Morelock, thence in an easterly direction on the traveled road across the bridge built by the County, thence on the traveled road in a north easterly course to the corner between the farms of Ch. A. Stevenson & J. G. Weaver on the West line, crossing Indian & Clarke's Creek on the bridges and following the grades to the foot of Clarke's Creek Hill, thence over the most practicable route to the end of the County road about 100 yds. West of the residence of Matt. Nickels

And it satisfactorily appearing to the Court, from proof filed herein, that due notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given as by law required: that more than twelve of said petitioners are legal householders residing in the vicinity of said road, and that a good and sufficient bond has been filed:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE COURT that J. M. Tucker, William Hine and Samuel Birrough be appointed Viewers, and Eugene Chase Surveyor, to view, survey and report upon said Proposed County Road and that they meet at the house of Henry Rinehart on the 20 day of January 1870 and duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.

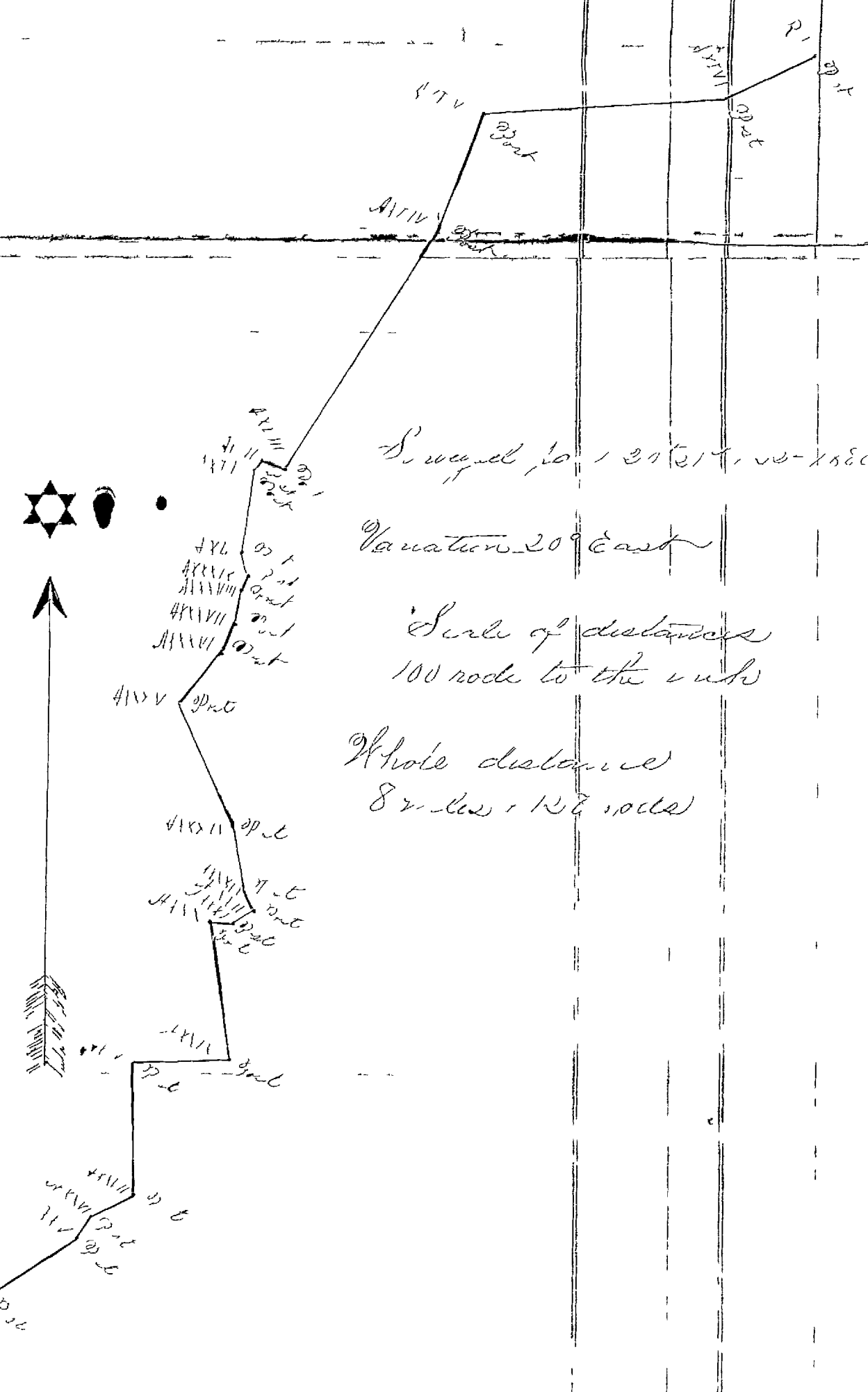

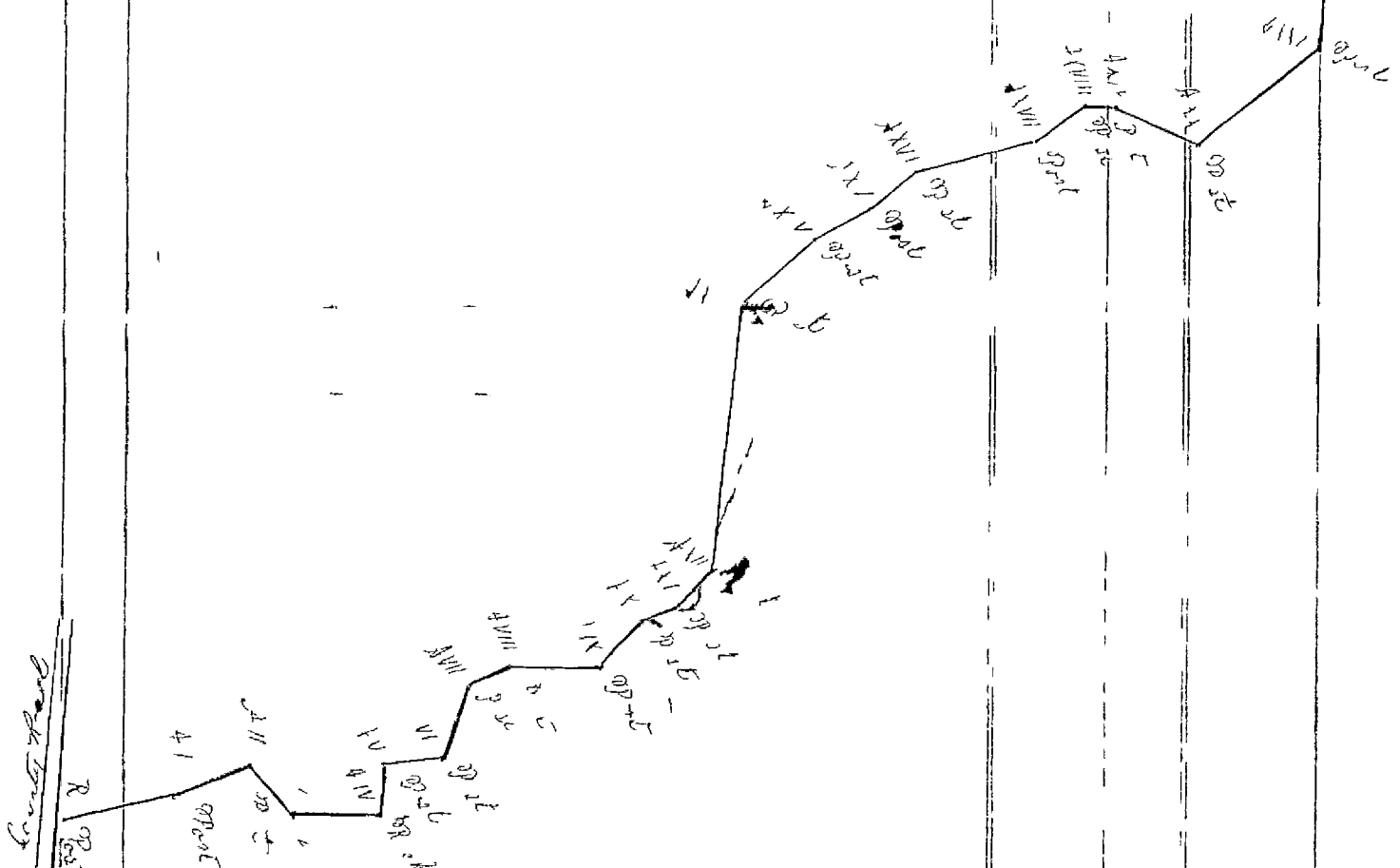
