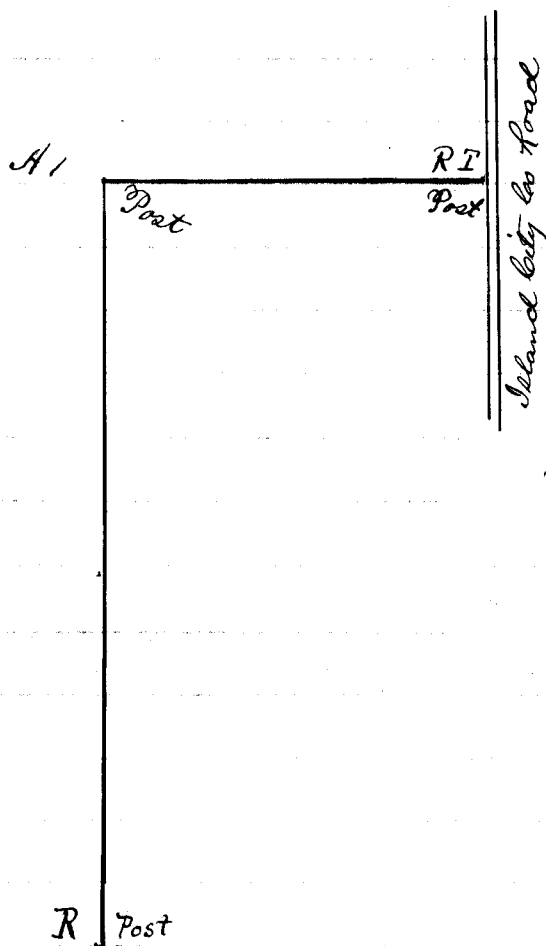
Survey of County Road in Town 2 S R 38 E

And it appearing to the satisfaction of the court that due notice of the pendency of these proceedings had been given and that proof of said notice had been given and filed and a bond having been filed conditioned for the payment of the costs of the viewing of said route should the report thereon be unfavorable, it was ordered that Wm. Mitchell Thomas Smith and R. J. Kellogg three disinterested parties bona fide householders of Union County Oregon be and they are hereby appointed viewers to view said route and Eugene Chase Surveyor to survey said route and that they meet and at the residence of W. M. Mitchell on the 16th day of January 1880 and after being duly sworn proceed upon their duties in this behalf.

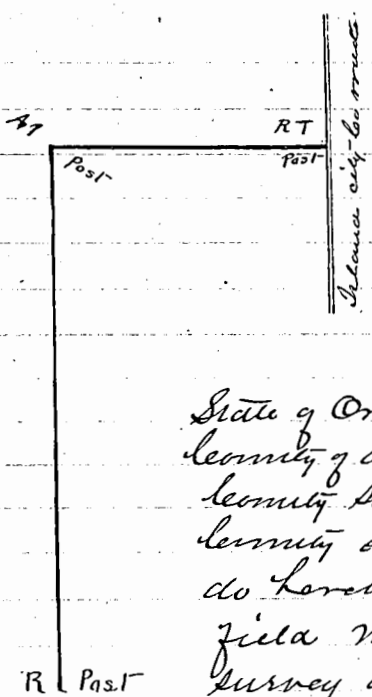
