

March 3<sup>rd</sup> 1880 In the matter of the  
division of Silver Lake  
precinct.

Now at this time was presented the petition of R. M. Dorney and others for the division of Silver Lake precinct. And it appearing to the court that it would be of convenience for the voters of said precinct to grant said petition. It was therefore ordered that said precinct be divided, and that the boundaries of said new district be as follows. Commencing at the head of Silver Lake; thence down the center of said Lake to its outlet, thence down the main channel of the Willow River to its confluence with Prairie Creek, thence N to the base line, thence E to Sheep Creek, thence up Sheep Creek to the base of the Eagle Creek Mountains, thence in a westerly direction along the base of said Mountains to the place of beginning.

In the matter of  
Road Petition of  
W<sup>W</sup> Malin et al

Now at this time was presented the petition of W<sup>W</sup> Malin and others praying the location and establishment of a County road as follows, to wit: Commencing at the school house in district No 4 on the line dividing the land of Frederick Mitchell and F.M. Mitchee and running on said line due East through the land of A.R. Robinson intersecting and terminating at the road running North from Cove at the NE corner of the land owned by Horwas Babington and the SE corner of the land of A.R. Robinson lately belonging to Daniel Weaver all of said roads being in Union County. And it appearing to the court from proof

filed in this court that due notice of the pendency of these proceedings had been given and a good and sufficient bond having been filed, and no reservation having been filed. It was ordered that John M. Phy, A.J. Harris and W.A. McCleary be appointed viewers and Eugene Chase as surveyor to view, survey, lay out and report upon said road and that they meet at the house of A.R. Robinson in town and that they meet on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1888 and after being sworn, enter upon their duties in this behalf.

Robinson on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of May 1880— and proceed to assess the said damage and report the same to this Court at the next regular Term, and that the Report of said Viewer be laid over until the next regular Term of this Court.
