


Hammack and presents to the court ^{a petition} signed by himself and many others asking for the location and establishment of a County road as follows to wit: Beginning at the North West corner of section 30 on the Summerville and Leabrande County road thence east along said line a sufficient distance to intersect the Summerville and Hendershot Point County road all in Union County Oregon.

And it appearing that due notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given as by law required and a good and sufficient bond filed with the Clerk of this Court.

It was therefore ordered that James E. Goodall Jasper Rinehart and E. C. Tumbler three interested householders of Union County Oregon be appointed viewers and Eugene Lakast Surveyor and that they meet at the house of J. W. Hammack on the 17th day of July ¹⁸⁸⁰ and after being first duly qualified proceed to view survey and locate said proposed County road and report their findings thereon at the next regular term of this Court.
