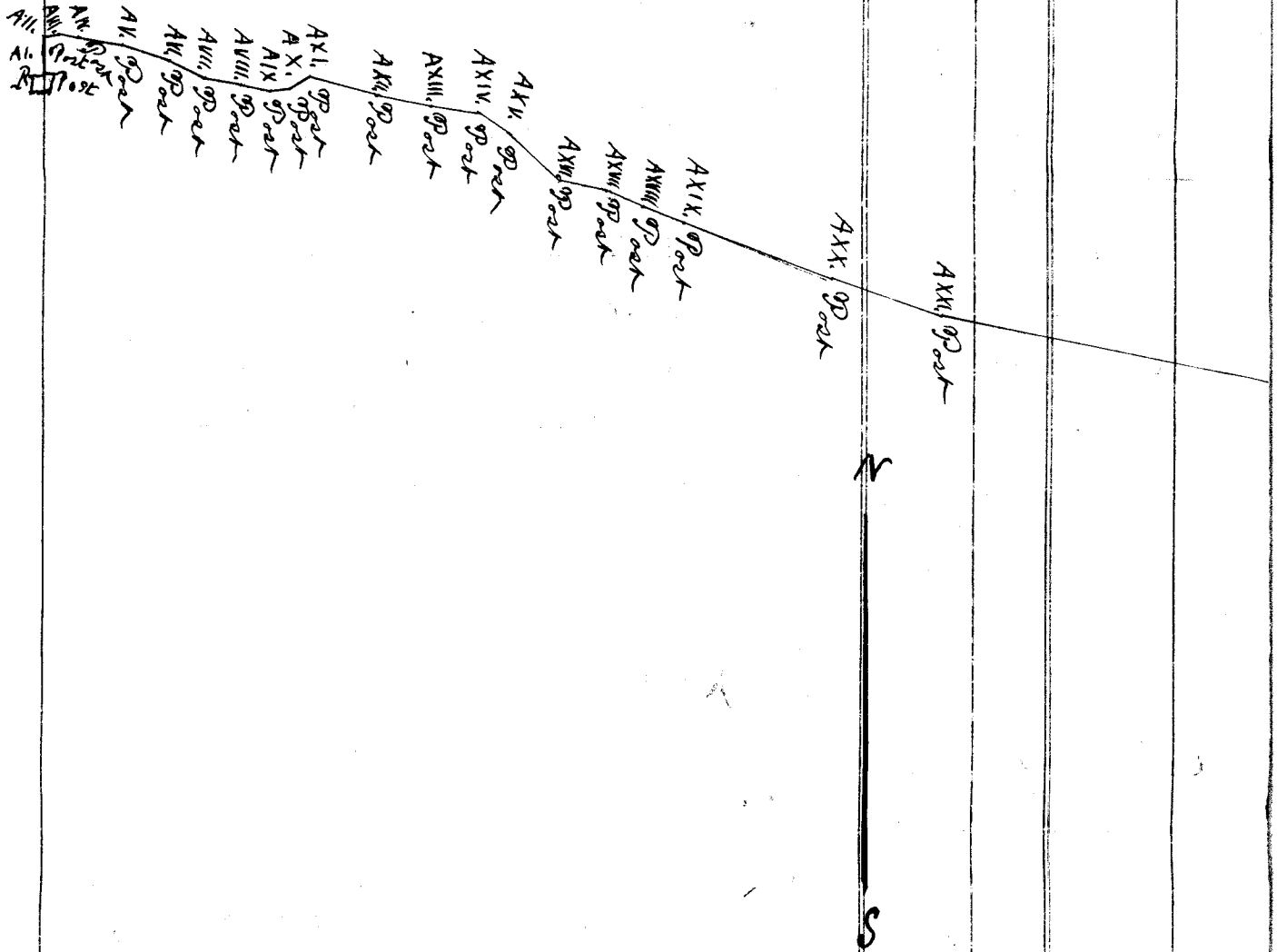
Survey of the County Road

On this day was presented the petition of J.B. Sams and more than twelve others praying for the location and establishment of a County Road as follows, to wit: Commencing at or near the residence of James Sams on Big Creek and running thence in a Southerly direction about four miles on the road now known as the Deaw road to Powder River at a point near the mouth of the Canyon about one mile above what is known as the Deaw place thence in an easterly direction to intersect the County road at or near the Sturgill Bridge. And it satisfactorily appearing to the Court from proof filed herein that due notice of the pendency of these proceedings has been given as by law required; that more than twelve of said petitioners are legal householders, residing in the vicinity of said road, and that a good and sufficient bond has been filed. It is therefore ordered by the Court that W^m Frazier Sr., J.P. Cornewell and Frank Leusich be appointed viewers and Eugene Lehare, Surveyor to view, survey and report upon said proposed road and that they meet at the residence of J.B. Sams on the 17th day of Sept-1880 and duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.
