appearing to the board that the Ladd Canyon  
road is in need of repair and that  
the road labor for said district is

not sufficient to repair said road. It is hereby ordered and adjudged that an appropriation be made out of the county fund to the amount of \$200<sup>00</sup> upon the express conditions that said district shall donate an equal and like amount for said purpose. And it is further ordered that should said amount be raised in said district then John Howard shall take charge and supervise said work, & said appropriation be disbursed upon and in accordance with certificate of the said John Howard duly issued from him to the effect that said labor had been performed. Said work to be completed on or before the 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1880
