That we, the undersigned, by these presents, that  
to G. H. Hitchcock and Benjamin Stanton  
of the precinct of Warsaw, Warren County  
and State of Oregon, agree to pay to  
the County of Warren the sum of two  
hundred dollars. The condition of  
the above obligation is - that, if the  
petition of the Petitioners, praying for  
a County road to be commenced at  
the S. E. corner of M. C. Israel's farm,  
and the S. W. corner of Benjamin Stanton's  
farm, and running thence to the Saw-  
Mill on Leatherins Creek, as described  
in their petition, be not granted  
by the County Court, for said County,  
to the said Petitioners, then the  
above obligation or so much thereof  
as shall pay the costs, and expenses,  
that may be incurred by reason of  
such view or review, shall be of  
full force and effect - otherwise to  
be null and void.

Catherine's Creek, through the  
French Settlement, and on  
the most direct route to the  
timber, and Saw Mill on  
said Creek ~~Creek~~, - would be

Corner of Ashleys farm and S.W. Corner of Stantons farm and thence running an Easterly course on the line of Crighton Stantons & Quicks thence passing the farms of Benson and Gates and leading up Cathlamet Creek through the french Settlement and on the most direct route to the timber and Saw Mill on said Creek

The bond accompanying said petition was accepted and proper proof having been offered as to the posting of said notice the petition was granted and J. Ashby, Geo Barlow and Fred Beard were appointed as Viewers and M. C. Israel Surveyor to map at the point of beginning at 9 o'clock a.m. on the 9th day of July 1867.

Stevens together with a Notice and bond praying for a license to sell Spirituous leguors in La Grande precinct for the term of Six months which bond was accepted and it was ordered that a license may issue to the said J. P. Stevens upon his filing a receipt from the County Treasurer for the Sum of fifty dollars for a term of Six months
