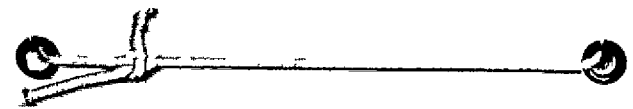

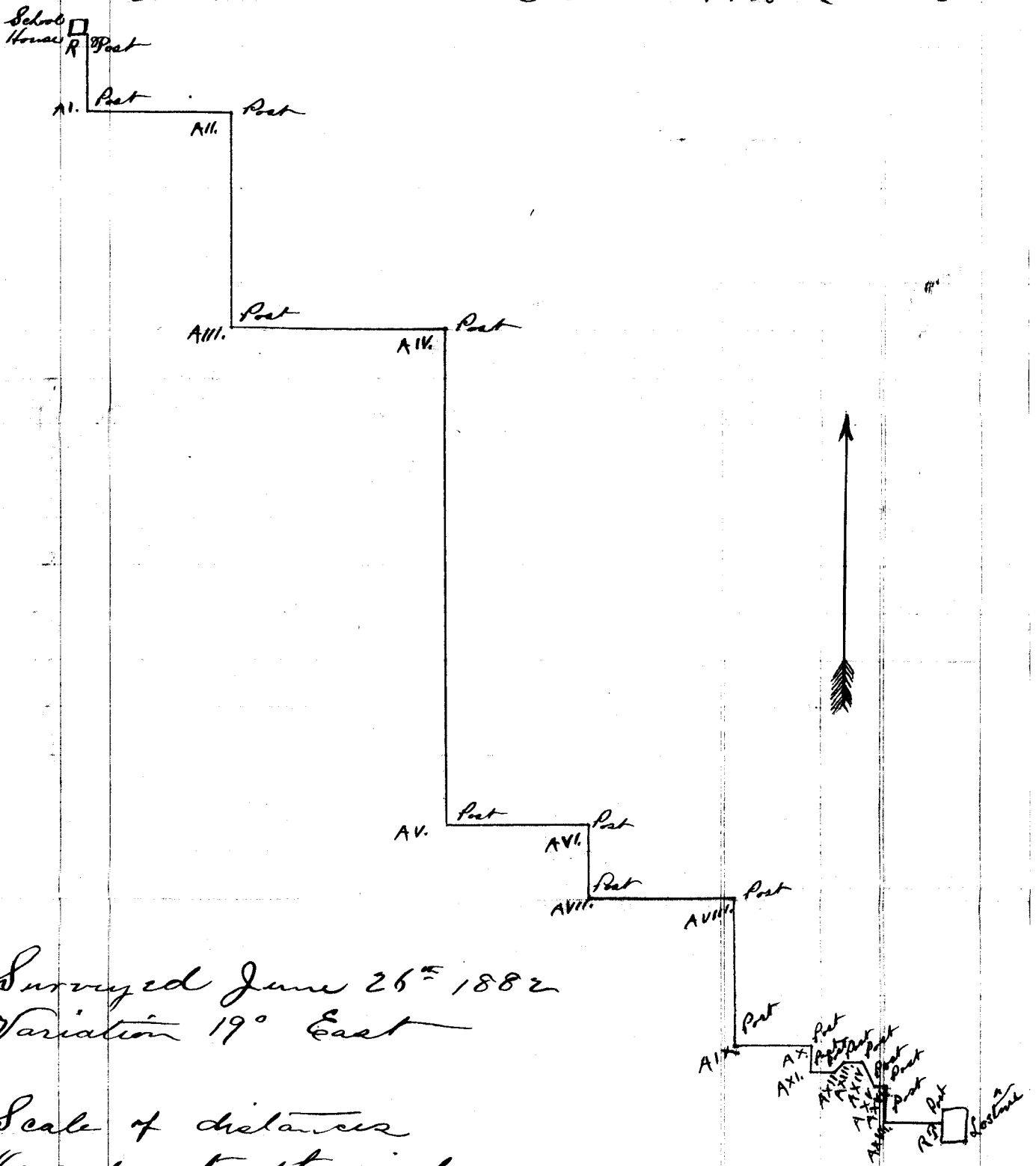

At a regular Term of the County Commissioners Court began and held at the Court House in the Union Union County Oregon on the 12th day of June A.D. 1872, there was present Hon. S. C. Craig Judge, S. W. Saunders Commissioner, Willis Stiff Clerk and R. J. Rogers Sheriff.

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made, the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of petition for a County Road near Lostine

On this day came C. S. Erwin who presents to the Court the petition of himself and more than 12 others praying the location and establishment of a County Road as follows, to wit: Beginning at what is known as the Sturgis School House in District No 34 thence South $\frac{1}{4}$ of mile; thence East $\frac{1}{2}$ mile; thence South $\frac{3}{4}$ of mile; thence East $\frac{3}{4}$ mile; thence South $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles; thence East $\frac{1}{2}$ mile; thence South about thirty five rods; thence in a southeasterly direction about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile on the most practicable route to Lostine; thence East to the South East Corner of the South west $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 10 T. 1. S. R. 43. E. And it satisfactorily appearing to the Court from proof filed herein that due notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given as by law required; that more than twelve of said petitioners are legal householders residing in the vicinity of said road and that a good and sufficient bond has been filed. It is therefore ordered by the Court that John M. Gibson, W. Douthett and J. H. Francis be appointed viewers and Eugene Chase Surveyor, to view survey and report upon said proposed

road and that they meet at the Sturgis School house on the 26th day of June 1882 and duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.

In the matter of location of

On this day came James Ogarth, who presents to the Court the petition of himself and 22 others praying the location and establishment of a County Road as follows, to wit: Beginning $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile south of James York's dwelling house on the County Road leading from C. Hagen via Wolf Creek to North Powder River thence East $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile; thence South $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile, thence East until it intersects the County Road leading from La Grande via Ladd Canyon to North Powder mills and it satisfactorily appearing to the Court, from proof filed herein, that due notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given as by law required; that more than twelve of said petitioners are legal landholders residing in the vicinity of said Road, and that a good and sufficient bond has been filed.
