Mr Woodell,

In my talk with you concerning our roads, I forgot to tell you there was a portion of the old road running parallel with the road now being viewed only three quarters of a mile distant; Said part of the old road is not dead, for it has been travel for the last fifteen years, & thus never has been an obstacle in the way. These facts we can prove & it can not be proven to the contrary. Also the men who are viewing the road all have their names on the petition, and are persons interested in the road. When they come to make their report ask them of the old road running West from Olo Derricks' gate to the new one running along the north line of Jim Holstine's Ranch are a mile apart, if the road is granted we are going to have a lawyer take hold of it, & investigate the matter & have sufficient to the road running East & West through the Valley.

July 21st, 1882.




Survey of proposed County road in Eagle Valley
