report our proceedings herein together
with a plan and specifications of said

It is ordered and adjudged by the Court that said report be accepted and said plan and specifications be adopted by this Court as the plan and specifications upon which said Bridge shall be built, and that the amount of said estimate to-wit: \$1006⁰⁰ be appropriated for the purpose of erecting such Bridge. And it is further ordered that a certified copy of said report, plan and specifications and of the orders of this Court be transmitted to the County Court of Baker County for the action of said Court as required by law.

Now at this time is presented to the Court a communication from the County Court of Baker County stating that said Court had had under consideration the plans specifications report and Journal Entries in the matter of building a Bridge across Lower Powder River between Union & Baker Counties, submitted to them by this Court and that they had accepted and adopted such plans & specifications; and this matter being now ready for further action by this Court, It is therefore ordered and adjudged by the Court that Joel B. Wolby be and he is hereby appointed Superintendent to superintend the letting and building of such Bridge, as provided by law.

In the matter of the
appointment of Supervisor
of Road District No 15

Now at this time it appearing to the Court that the residents of Road District No 15 of this County desired the appointment of O. LeFage as Supervisor of said District, and Andrew Wilkinson who had been hitherto at this term of the Court appointed as such Supervisor, being desirous of being relieved from serving It is therefore ordered and adjudged by the Court that the appointment of Andrew Wilkinson as Supervisor of Road District No 15 of this County be and the same is hereby rescinded and set aside and O. LeFage is hereby appointed Supervisor of said District for the present year.
