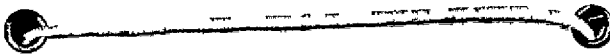


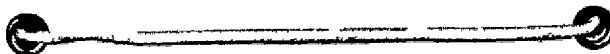

Thursday May 15th 1884

Court met pursuant to adjournment, present the same officers as on yesterday.

Due proclamation of the opening of the Court having been made the Journal of yesterdays proceedings was read, approved and is now here signed

Whereupon the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of a proposed
County Road petitioned for
by W. H. Craig George Beck
and others.

Now at this time is presented to the Court the petition of W. H. Craig, George Beck and twenty three others, Citizens of Union County praying for a change in a certain County Road and location of a new road, and it appearing to the Court from the proof filed herein that due and legal notice of the pendency of this proceeding had not been given as required by law It is therefore ordered that said petition be denied and dismissed, at the costs of the petitioners.

In the matter of a proposed
County Road petitioned for
by J. B. Williamson and others

Now at this time is presented to the Court the petition of J. B. Williamson and fifteen others Citizens of Union County praying for the location of a County Road commencing at Catherine Creek Bridge and running west, and it appearing to the Court from an examination of the petition that there are not twelve householders residing in the vicinity of the said proposed County Road signing said petition, and that the law has not therefore ^{been} complied with It is ordered and adjudged by the Court that said petition be denied and dismissed, at the costs of the petitioners
