To the Honorable County Court of

Your petitioners the undersigned residents, house-
holders and legal voters living along the line
in the immediate vicinity of the herein-
after proposed County Road would most
respectfully yet earnestly petition your Hon-
orable body to view out locate and grant
a County Road as nearly as practicable on
the following described Rout Twid.
Commencing at a point at the Southeast cor-
ner of the Town Site of Alder about 40 Rods
due north of the Southeast corner of Section
(10) ten town I South of Range 44 E. from
running thence 40 Rods due west to a point
near the residence Thos. Beazley thence in
a Southwesterly direction about 125 yards to a
point near Thos Beazley new Barn thence
in a Westerly direction a distance of about
45 Rods to the South West corner of the
~~South West fourth~~ ^{fourth} of the Southeast of said Section
one and one fourth miles west to the ~~North~~
East corner of the Northeast fourth of the said
West fourth of Section 16. thence three fourths of

Friday June 11-1884

In the matter of a proposed
County Road petitioned for by
W.P. Lamms et-al

Now at this time is presented
to the Court the petition of W.P. Lamms et-al
praying for the location of a County Road as follow
to wit: Commencing at a point at the South East
corner of the town site of Alder about 40 Rods due
north of the South east corner of Sec. 110 Township 2
South of Range 44 E.W.M running thence 40 Rods due
west to a point near the residence of Thos. Kasey,
thence in a southerly direction about 125 yards to
a point near Thos. Kasey's new barn, thence in a
westerly direction a distance of about 45 Rods to
the South West corner of the S.E. quarter of the S.E.
Quarter of said Sec. Thence 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ miles west to the North
West corner of the North East corner quarter of the
North East Quarter of Sec. Sixteen (16). Thence three
fourths of one mile south & thence one and one fourth
miles west - the terminus of said proposed
Road. All of which points and places are situated
in Union Co., State of Oregon. It also factorily
appearing to the Court from proof filed herein
that due and legal notice of the pendency of
the proceeding had been given as required by law.
And that more than twelve of said petitioners
are legal householders living in the vicinity of
said proposed County Road, and that due
~~and~~ and sufficient bond had been filed herein.
Therefore it is ordered by the Court that D.B.
Baro, Benj. Boswell and A.C. King be appointed
Viewers and Fred Limonis Surveyor, to view
Survey and report upon said proposed County
Road and that they meet at the store of A.C. King
on July 28-1884 and duly qualify before entering
upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.

Second Judicial Day

Thursday Sept. 4 1874

In the matter of the County
Road Petitioned for by W. P. Samuels etc.

Now at this time is presented to the Court
the report of Surveyor heretofore appointed by the Court
in the above entitled road, accompanied by report of
Surveyor and plan and field notes of the Survey, which
report is read in open Court for the first time and
pursuant to the provisions of the Statute in such
cases made and provided, it is ordered that said
report be laid over for a second reading on another
day of this term.

In the matter of extending the time
of Assessor for completing the
Assessment for the year 1874 & 1875

Now at this time is presented to the Court
the Petition of C. P. Woodall, Assessor of Union County
Oreg. asking that the time for the completion of the
assessment of the County for the year 1874, be extended
to the first Monday of Oct. 1874. And it appearing to the
Court that the time for completing the assessment of
the County as specified by the Statute, is not sufficient;
and that the Statute provides that the County Court at a
regular term thereof may extend the time of the
assessor for completing such assessment, the Court
therefore grants an extension of time as aforesaid for in said
petition viz: to the first Monday of Oct. 1874 for
the said Assessor to make his final report to this Court.

In the matter of the County Road 3
Petitioned for by Mr. P. Lane et al 3

On this day is read the second time
the viewers Report on the above described proposed
County Road and upon an examination of the
petition and Surveyors Report herein, it appearing
to the Court that the beginning point named
in the petition can not be determined by the
Surveyor and that the survey of said road
does not correspond with the points named in
said petition. It is therefore ordered that said
petition be dismissed and that the petitioners
pay the costs of this proceeding
