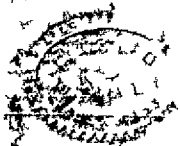

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made the following business was transacted

In the matter of

Now at this time was presented an petition of Arch Gordon asking a license to sell Groceries and Merchandise in Union County for a term of Six Months which application was granted and the same being accompanied with a receipt from the County Treasurer for the sum of Five Dollars it was ordered that a license issue to the said A. Gordon for a term of Six Months from this date

In the matter of a County Road  
Petition by J. W. Pastness et al

Now at this time was presented a petition of praying for a change in a County road commencing as follows To vacate that portion of the County Road from Oro Dell to Union commencing at Tillmans North line and terminating at James Pastness East line and locate a County Road on the road now traveled and known as the "Hull Road" from the starting point of the proposed vacation and terminating on the East line of James Pastness field and intersecting the line of Survey of the Oro Dell and Union County Road at the most convenient point which said petition being duly accompanied by an oath verifying the posting of notices in accordance with law and also a bond duly accepted It was therefore ordered that said petition be granted and ordered that D. A. McAlister, J. H. McAlister and Geo Horsepool be and they are hereby appointed as Viewers to view



At a regular term of the County Court of Union County Oregon held at the Court House in La Grande Oregon on the Sixth day of July 1869 there was present S. Alberson County Judge H. C. Craig Sheriff John McDowell County Commissioner and C. S. McClomas County Clerk

Now at this time it appearing to the Court that the Viewers heretofore appointed to view a County road, "Commencing at the ford above the Hubner ranch and running on the most practicable route to the House of Henry Henshaw thence west to the Section line dividing Sections Number Eight and Nine thence South Eighty rods thence west on the most practicable route to intersect the lane between Wm. Patton and S. S. Morton thence to the town of Summerville - have failed to receive their said Notice of appointment, it is therefore ordered that J. C. Standley, Chas. Wells, and C. A. Keelev be and they are hereby appointed as Viewers to view said road to meet at the town of Summerville the terminus of said road on Saturday July 24<sup>th</sup> at Eleven o'clock A.M. to view said proposed County Road

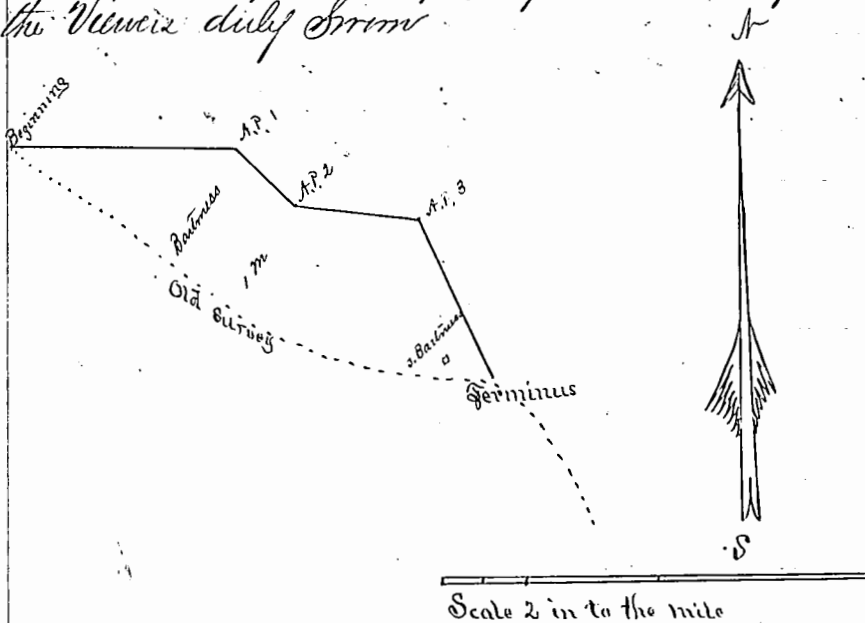
Now at this time was presented the report of the Viewers and Surveyor heretofore appointed to view and report on a County road running from Crockett to Union and said report being read on the first day was laid over until tomorrow

and the Viewers having been duly Sworn, it was Ordered and adjudged that Said road be declared a public highway and ordered opened as per the accompanying plat of the Survey before mentioned.

In the Matter of  
a County Road from  
Oro Dell to Uruin



Now at this time was presented the report of the Viewers and Surveyors heretofore appointed to view and Survey a proposed County road from Oro Dell to Uruin and Said Viewers having reported in favor of said proposed County road in accordance with the Notes of the Survey and plat of the same as follows viz "Survey made on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of May 1889 Commencing at the N.E. Corner of Sehlmanns field and running thence East 63 $\frac{1}{2}$  Chs to A.P. No. 1 thence E by 30 $^{\circ}$  S 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  Chs to A.P. 2 and 1 Mile 24 $\frac{1}{2}$  Chs thence E by 22 $^{\circ}$  S 23 Chs to A.P. 3 thence S by 10 $^{\circ}$  E 33 Chs to the terminus of the proposed Change Making the distance one Mile 5 Furlongs and 24 rods which said report was properly certified to by the Surveyor and the Viewers duly Sworn



it was ordered and adjudged that said road be declared a public highway and ordered opened as per the accompanying Plat of the Survey before mentioned
