as follows to wit

Commencing at the south
end of the Bridge on the Lake fork
of the Wallora river near the residence
of W^o Wood Esq and running in
a southern and eastern ^{direction} keeping as
near the foot of the hill on the east
and north as practicable for a good
road to a point immediately north
of the present residence of Henry
Miller Esq situated on the NW¹/₄ of
the SE¹/₄ of Section 32 Township 1, S
Range 44 E a distance of 1/4 mile
more or less. Thence east and south
to the NE corner of the SE¹/₄ of the
SE¹/₄ of Section 32, Thence South
1/4 mile to the SE corner of the SE¹/₄
of the SE¹/₄ of Section 32, all of Town-
ship 1 south, Range 44 East, a total
distance of 2 1/4 miles more or less
Intersecting the present road at the last
named point

And would further ask that
the present road between the points
above named be vacated as soon
as the road is open for travel on the pro-
posed change, or such parts of it as
do not conflict with the change pe-
