In the Matter of the
establishing of a new
Election Precinct

Now at this time upon the petition of legal voters of Union County Oregon, It is ordered by the Court that a new election precinct be and is hereby established with the following boundaries to wit: commencing at the S.E. corner of Sec. 33 Township one north of Range 44 East Willamette Meridian thence East along the base line to N. S.E. corner of Township one north of Range 46 East of Willamette Meridian thence north a distance of twelve miles to the North East corner of Township 2 north of Range 46 East of the Willamette Meridian thence West a distance of fifteen miles to the North West corner of Sec. 3 Township two north of Range 44 E. of M. thence South to the place of beginning said precinct to be known
