First

Respectfully though earnestly represent
 That what is known as the Hallowa
 Cañon Road situated in Union County and
 being the only thoroughfare or traveled
 road between Elk Flat and the Wallowa
 valley has been incorporated upon by
 J. B. Smith, W. M. Daniel and Matt
 Johnson under the Corporation laws of
 State of Oregon as a Commercial Corporation

Second

That the said Wallowa Cañon road
 was surveyed and laid out by authority of
 said County Court and public funds
 appropriated and expended upon said
 road besides large sums of money and
 labor donated by Citizens of Union County
 in opening and maintaining said road

Third

That as a condition of donating said
 large amounts of money and labor
 by the said citizens the said County Court
 was to have full control and jurisdiction
 of and over said Road.

Fourth

That we feel that our rights and
 the rights of the said County Court have been
 infringed upon by said incorporation
 and we insist upon the said County
 Court maintaining its control and
 jurisdiction over said road

Fifth

That so soon as the said Corporation
 shall place a Toll gate upon said
 Wallowa Cañon road and begin to collect
 toll from the traveling public we ask
 that the said County Court shall
 forthwith issue a Perpetual Injunction
 against said Wallowa Cañon Road
 Company restraining it from erecting
 any obstruction and collecting of toll
 from the travel over said road and
 for which we shall ever pray

Now at this time is presented to the Court the petition of over three hundred of the citizens of the Wallowa Valley Union County Oregon remonstrating against the incorporating of the Wallowa Canyon road. and the Court upon consideration of the matter find that there has been no toll gate yet erected on the road as heretofore incorporated upon and that until the same is done, or some act attempted by the incorporators of said road to obstruct said road the court can not act in the matter. It is therefore ordered that the further consideration of this matter be and the same is hereby postponed until the act of the incorporators will require the action of the Court.

Now at this time comes A. L. Saunders and files his return of delinquent taxes together with verified statement of demands turned over to the treasurer of state of 1885 and delinquent taxes collected & turned over to treasurer and of errors on assessment Roll by over assessment etc which statement and list of delinquent taxpayers is by the Court duly examined.
