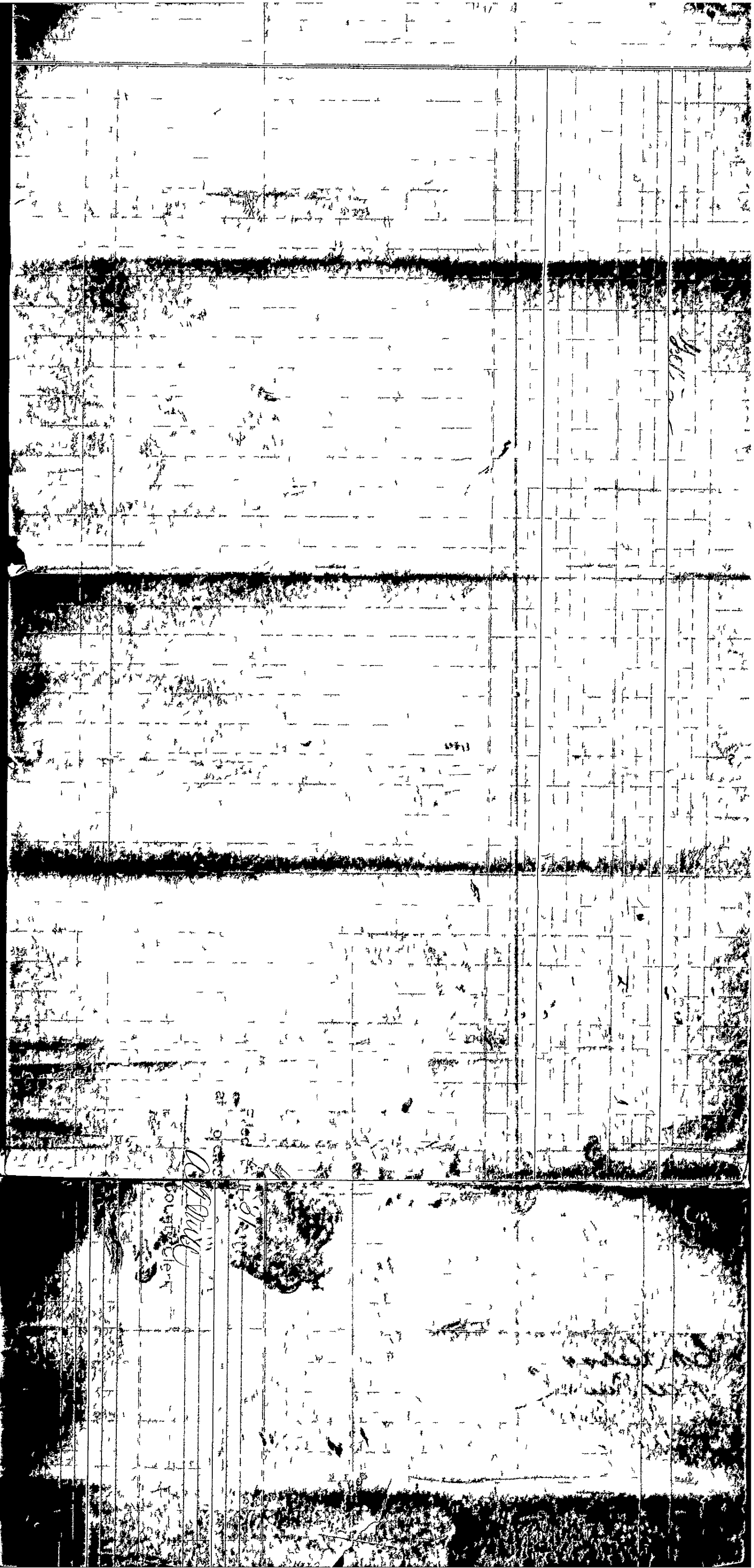

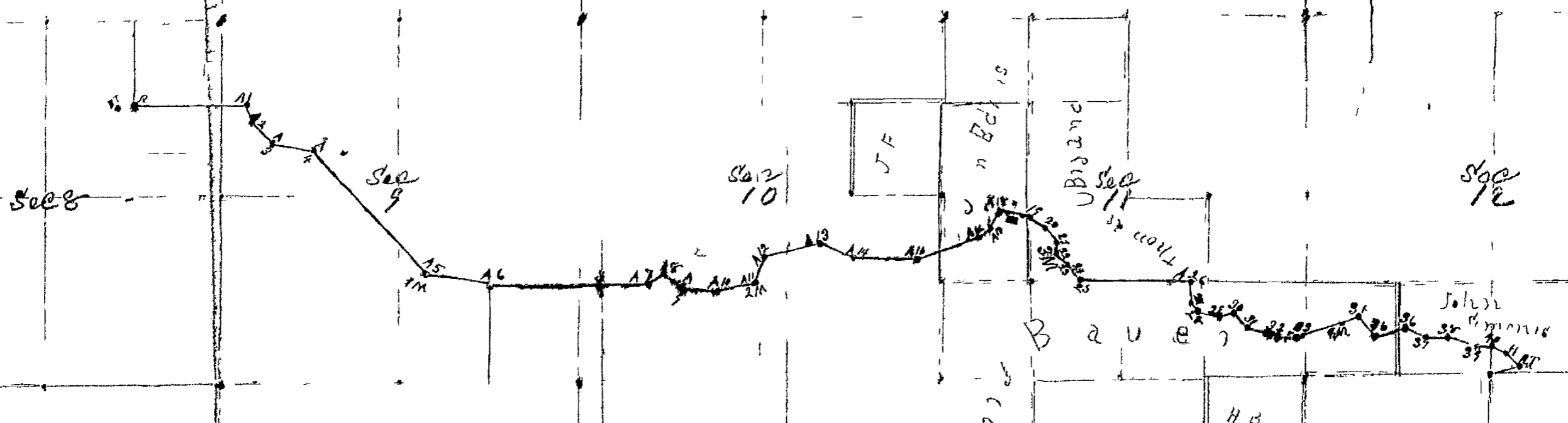

Proclamation being made of the opening of Court the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the Matter of a petition
of a proposed Road petitioned
for by James Wilkinson and
others

On this day came James Wilkinson who presents to the Court the petition of himself and fifty four others praying for the establishment of a County Road forty feet in width. Beginning at the South West corner of the N E 1/4 of the N E 1/4 of Sec 8, T. 6 S. R. 38 East N. M. and running East to the Bluff, then in a South Easterly course on the most practicable route to the N. W. corner of the S E 1/4 of the S E 1/4 of the S E 1/4 of Sec 9, T. 6 S. R. 38 E. N. M., thence East 160 rd thence in an Easterly direction on the most practicable route following the Gulch to the house John Eiders, thence in a South Easterly direction on the most practicable route through to the lands of John Simonis, thence in an Easterly direction on the most practicable ^{route} through the land of John Simonis to intersect the County road on Wolf Creek. And it satisfactorily appearing to the Court from proof filed therein that due notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given as by law required; that more than twelve of said petitioners are legal householders residing in the vicinity of said road, and that a good and sufficient bond has been filed therein. It is therefore ordered by the Court that Messrs James Abraham and D. W. Nelson be and they are hereby appointed Viewers and J. W. Kimbrell be and he is hereby appointed Surveyor to view, survey and report on upon said proposed road and that they meet at the house of John Simonis on the 20th day of September A. D. 1886 and duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.
