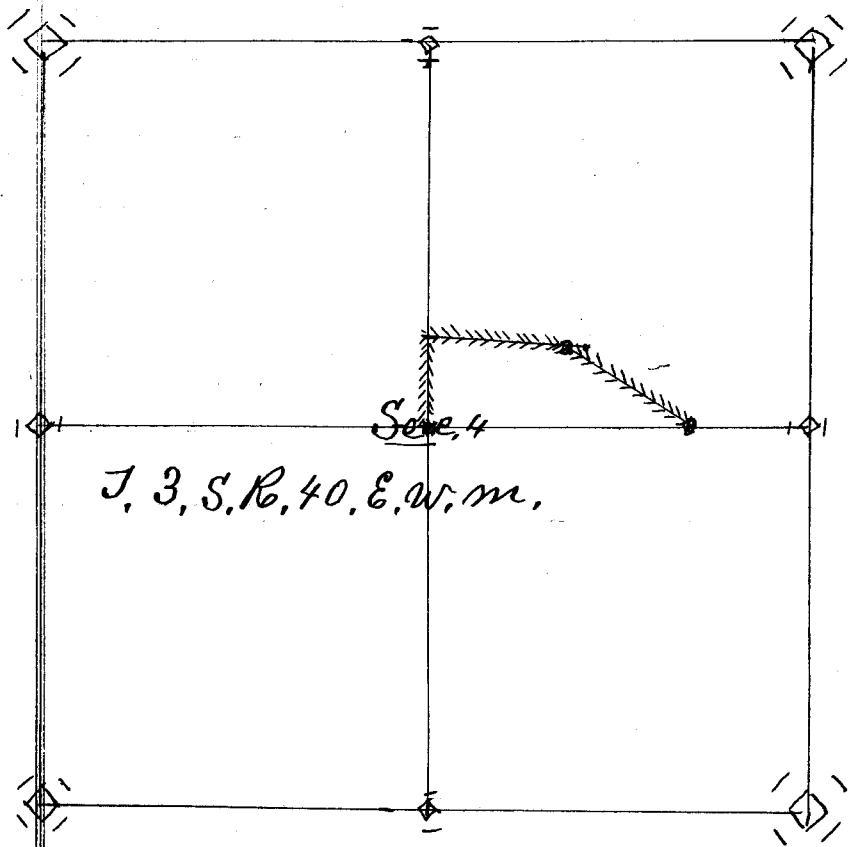

Mann & Co., authorizing and empowering them to keep and sell spirituous, malt and vinous liquors in the town of Sparta, in Eagle Precinct, in the County of Union and State of Oregon in less quantities than one quart for the period of one year from this date

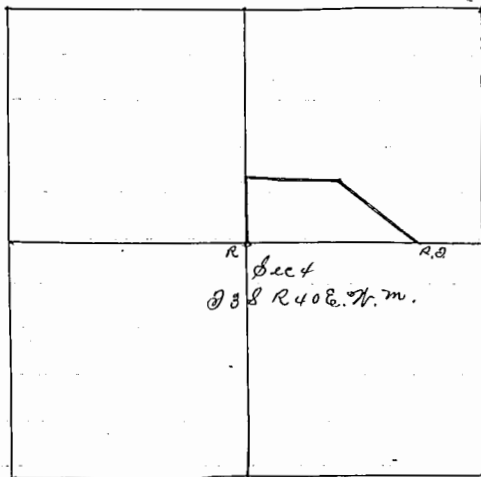
