That Warren Frazer, Jasper Mitchell, and C. H. Prescott be appointed Viewers and J. W. Kimbrell Surveyor to view and survey and report on said proposed road, and that they meet at the Farm of David Bilty at the mouth of Pyle Canyon on Tuesday, the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of March 1887 at 10 o'clock A.M. and duly qualify before they enter on the discharge of their duty in this behalf.

In the Matter of the  
Purchase of the  
Meacham Toll Road

Now at this time is presented to the Court the petition of P. A. Mahaffey and 45 others asking and praying that the County Court appropriate the sum of Four Hundred Dollars toward purchasing what is known as the Old Meacham Toll Road for the purpose of making the same a County Road. And it appearing to the Court that it would be greatly to the advantage of a large number of citizens and taxpayers of the County to have the same made a County road and the Court being fully advised in the premises, It is therefore considered, ordered and adjudged that the petition be allowed and that \$400<sup>00</sup> be appropriated from the County funds in the hands of the treasurer, not otherwise appropriated, for this purpose, and that whenever said citizens have made up sufficient <sup>and additional</sup> means to pay for the same and to make it a free road, that the Clerk of this Court draw a warrant on the County Treasurer for the said amount, to wit \$400<sup>00</sup>.

Whereupon Court adjourned till tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock.
