



In the Matter of Cancelling
Old County warrants

It appearing to the Court that the Legislature at its last session passed an act providing for the cancellation of all County warrants that have been issued more than seven years. It is therefore ordered that the Clerk prepare a list of all County warrants outstanding and uncancelled that were issued more than seven years prior to July 1st 1889 and submit the same to his Court at its meeting on July 19th 1889.

In the Matter of an
Appropriation on

the Hog Valley Road } This matter came on to be heard on the petition of numerous taxpayers asking that an appropriation of \$300⁰⁰ be made to assist in opening up the County road petitioned for by James Haynes and others and leading from the Pyle Canyon road near the residence of Joseph Yourell to the Ladd Canyon road near the residence of Genl Stevens. And after due consideration had it is ordered by the Court that the sum of \$200⁰⁰ be appropriated out of the County Treasury to assist in opening up said road & be expended under the supervision of Nelson Schoonover, when the citizens interested in the road shall have expended the sum of one hundred Dollars (\$100⁰⁰) thereon.
