The undersigned twelve citizens householders & others of the County of Union State of Oregon residing in the vicinity along the route where the hereafter described road & desired road is to be laid out respectfully petition your Honor body to grant & lay out a County road in the County of Union & State aforesaid to commence at a point at or near a road sign poste about one and one-quarter miles East of La Grand to run thence in an Easterly direction towards Catherine Creek about ten miles & to Cross said Creek at what is known as the Tully Bridge to run thence in a southeasterly direction passing Hendersons point near Groves Blacksmith Shop to the the west end of what is known as Frenches Lane a distance of about one and one-quarter miles thence easterly through said Frenches Lane to a point near Mr Daniels store a distance of about two & one-half miles thence in a southeasterly direction to a mill known as the Mc Sottles Sawmill a distance of about two miles thence in an

Easterly direction to Summit of the mountain a distance of about four & one-half miles at which point said road is to terminate all of said points & places being in the County of Oregon Dated this the 2nd day of August A.D. 1870

County Court of Union County Oregon to be holden at La Grand Oregon on the first Monday of September next A.D. 1870 an application will be made by the undersigned & others to said County Court to Grant & lay out a County road to follow as near as practicable & feasible the following route to wit to Commence at a point at or near a road sign post about one & one quarter $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles East of La Grand to run thence in an easterly direction towards Catherine Creek a distance of about ten miles and to cross said Bridge Creek at what is known as the Tully Bridge to run thence in a south easterly direction passing behind the farm near Grouse Black Smith Shop to the west end of what is known as the French Laine a distance of about one & one quarter $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles thence easterly through said French Laine to a point near Mr Daniels Store in the Cove a distance of about two & 2 miles thence South Easterly to a saw mill known as the McLothlin Sawmill a distance of about two & 2 miles thence easterly to summit of the mountains a distance of about four & 4 miles which point said road is to terminate All of said points & places being in Union County Ogn.

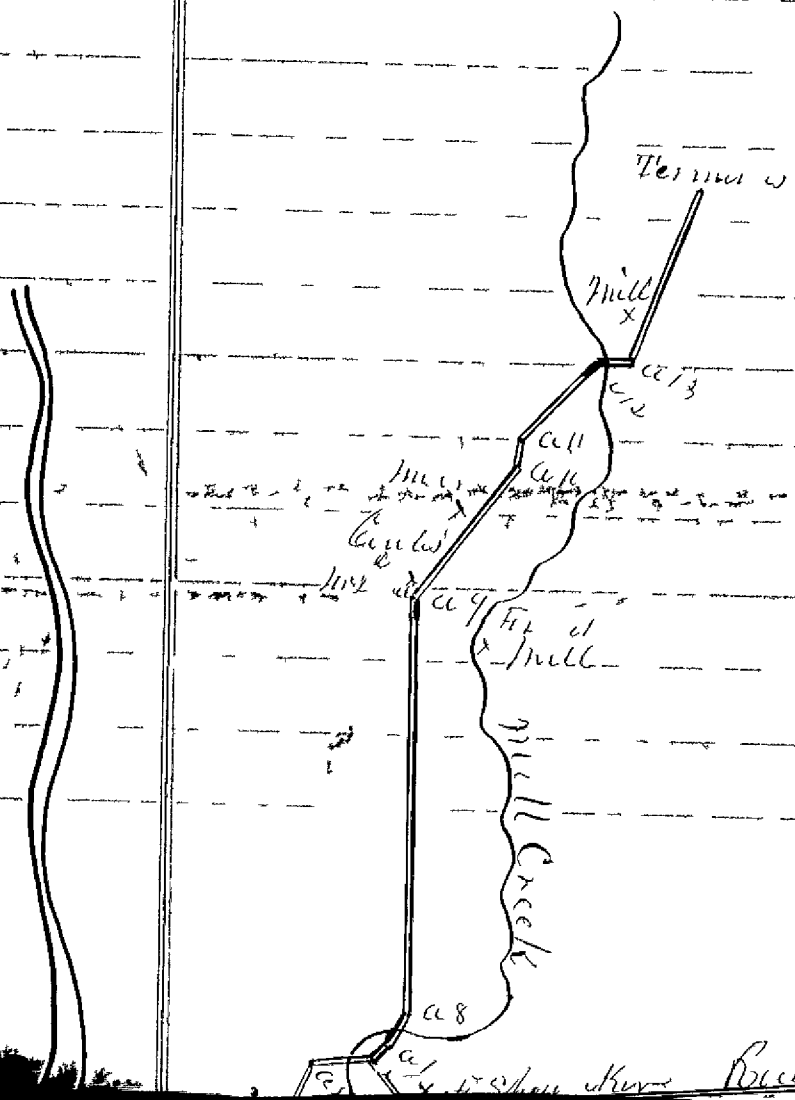

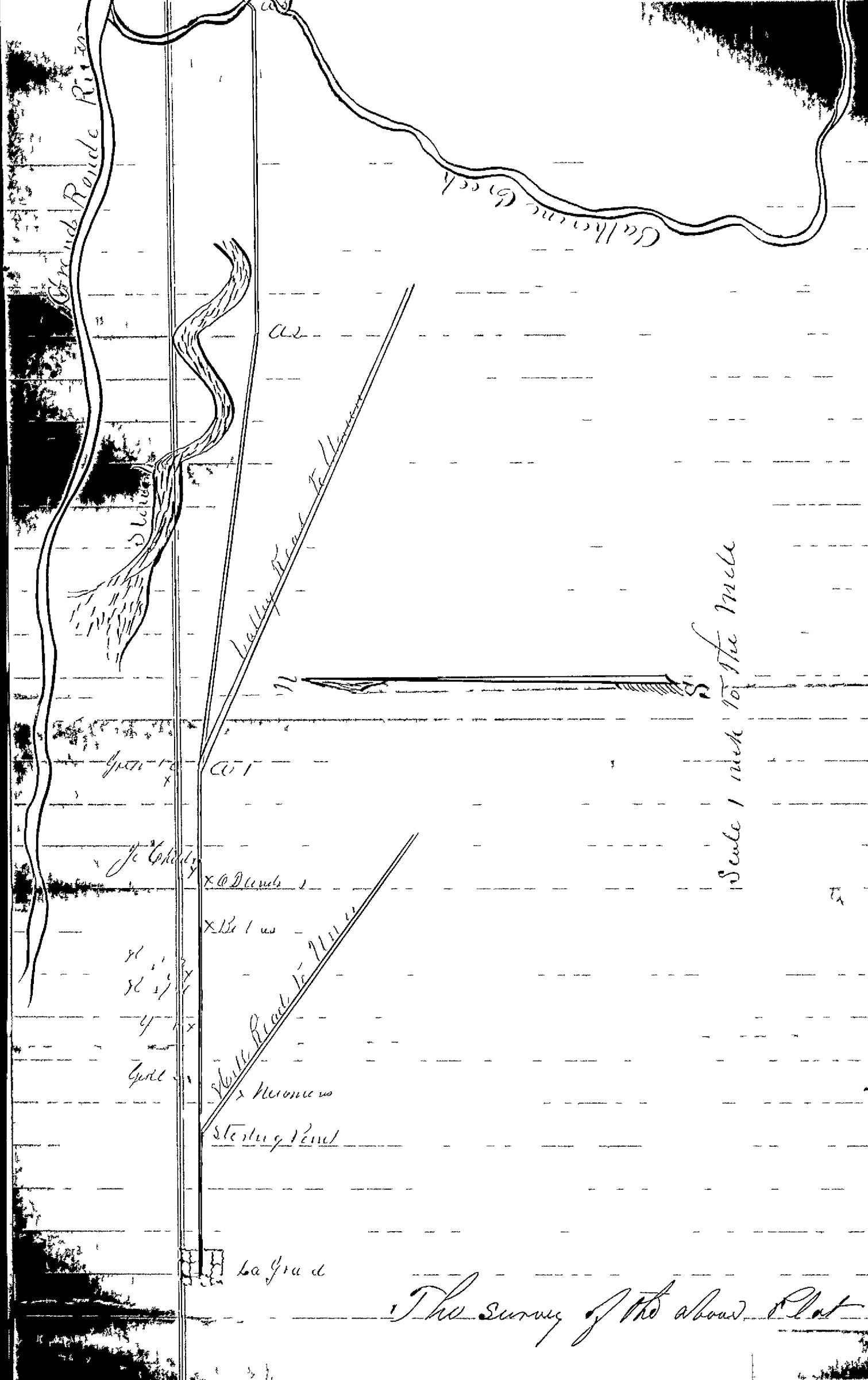

At a regular term of the County Court of Union County Oregon began and held at the Court House in La Grande Oregon on the 9th day of Sept 1869 there was present Hon S. Alberson County Judge John Mc Dorrell County Commissioner A. C. Craig Sheriff and E. S. Mc Comas County Clerk

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made the following business was Transacted

In the matter of County Road from Heebner Ranch to Summerville

Now at this time was taken up and read for the first time the report of the Viewers and Surveyor of a proposed County Road from the Heebner Ranch in said County to the town of Summerville

In the matter of a County road from La Grande to McLaughlins mill

Now on this day was presented a petition praying for the location of a County Road as follows viz Commencing at the sign post about one and one fourth miles from the town of La Grande (cars) and running thence to the bridge on Catherine Cross near Hendersons point on the nearest and most practicable route thence to the Blacksmith Shop of St. Erins thence on the nearest and most practicable route via David Colles to Dodsons Store thence via McLaughlins mill to the Summit of the mountains on the nearest and most practicable route. Which petition having truly sworn along said proposed road and also being accompanied by a bond for the payment of all Expenses necessarily incurred as required by law and there being no remonstrance to said petition it was ordered that said petition be granted and that Frank Partness, F. Shoemaker and D. A. McAllister be and they are hereby appointed to view said road to meet at La Grande on Friday 17th Sept 1869 at ten o'clock J. L. Curtis was appointed as Surveyor

mentioned all of which points and places are in Union County, Oregon

Whereupon it was Ordered by the Court that ^{Severest Rodine & 14 others} Stewart ~~W. G. Martin~~ and Charles Mc'Clure and William Hutcheson be and they are hereby appointed to view mark and locate said proposed road and J. L. Curtis is hereby appointed Surveyor all of whom shall meet at the House of Ben Stanton in Union on the 15th day of September 1870 and report their proceedings to this Court at the next Term thereof.

Now at this time it was Ordered by the Court that the Salary of School Superintendent be and the same shall be fixed at three Hundred dollars per year or twenty five dollars per month for his services as such Superintendent

Now at this time was presented the petition of O. D. Andrews and others praying for a County Road in words as follows to wit:

To the Honorable County Court of the County of Union State of Oregon

The Undersigned twelve Citizens householders & others of the County of Union & State of Oregon residing in the vicinity and along the route where the hereafter described road and designed road is to be laid out respectfully petition your Hon. body to grant & lay out

a County Road in the County of Union & State aforesaid to Commence at a point at or near a Road Signpost about one & one quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ miles East of Lalpande to run thence in an Easterly direction towards Cathlamet Creek about ten miles & to Cross said Creek at what is known as the Tully Bridge to run thence in a Southeastly direction passing Hendersons point near Ground Blacksmith Shop to the west end of what is known as Frenchs Lane a distance of about one and one quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ miles thence Easterly through said Frenchs Lane to appoint near McDaniels Store a distance of about two miles, thence in an Easterly direction to a Saw mill known as the McLochlin Saw mill a distance of about two miles, thence in an Easterly direction to Summit of the Mountain a distance of about four miles at which points and places being in Union County Oregon dated this the 2nd day of August A.D. 1870

Curtis is hereby appointed Surveyor of said Road to meet in Lalpande at the House of Thos O'Brien on the 17th day of September 1870 And Report their proceedings at the next term of this Court

Court then Adjourned until tomorrow Morning at 8 O'clock

appointed Viewers to meet on the 15th day of September 1870 have not been legally notified. It is therefore Ordered that the time be extended until the 13th day of October next that said Viewers with J L Curtis Surveyor meet at the House of Ben Stantons on said day and view and mark said proposed road and report their doings thereon at the November term of this Court And that the Clerk make out and deliver to the Sheriff notices of said Order

In the Matter of

Now at this time it appearing that John L Caviness Thomas Baird and S O Sweetshamer heretofore appointed Viewers on a certain proposed County Road to meet at the House of Tho^s O'Brien on the 17th day of September last had not had sufficient notice thereof as required by law, It is therefore Ordered that the time be extended to the 18th day of October next for said Viewers and Surveyor to meet at said O'Brien and proceed to mark & view out said proposed Road and report their proceedings thereon at the November term of this Court And that the Clerk make out and the Sheriff serve the required notices

The Report of the Viewers heretofore appointed to
view a proposed County Road submitted the following
Report to wit

To the Hon Board of County Commissioners for Union
County Oregon. We the undersigned appointed by your
Hon Body to view out a County Road from a point one
and one fourth of a mile east of Galpanda to a point
in the Cove on the Summit of the Mountains near Mc
Laughlins Saw mill. We have to report that we met
on the 21st day of October 1870 and after being duly sworn
proceeded with J. G. Curtis as Surveyor to view out and
survey said Road. That we believe the accompanying
plat and notes of the survey to be correct, and that
the Road as viewed by us is not only practicable but of
general benefit to the Community and the citizens
generally living in the vicinity of the line of the Road
all of which is respectfully submitted

Which Report was accepted by the Court
and the plat thereof ordered to be spread
upon the records. And the same declared
to be a public Highway in accordance with
the plat hereof and that Supervisors are
hereby authorized to open the same and
keep it in repair as other public Roads.
And it is ordered that the County Clerk
notify the Supervisors on the line of said
Road of the action of this Court, that they
may open said road accordingly.
