Now comes David Beveridge and presents to the court his petition for a license to sell spirituous, malt and various liquors in quantities less than one quart, in the precinct of North Powder for the period of one year. And it appearing to the court from proof filed herein that due and legal notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given, that said petitioner having paid into the county treasury the sum of One Hundred Dollars, being the price required by law therefor and having produced and filed the Treasurer's receipt for the same and having filed a good and sufficient undertaking herein and in all things else complied with the law herein. It is therefore considered and ordered that a license issue to the said David Beveridge authorizing and empowering him to sell spirituous, malt and various liquors in quantities less than one quart in the Precinct of North Powder for the period of one year from the date hereof.

At this time is presented to the court the petition of Geo. O'Connor and 52 others asking that the county make an appropriation of \$600.00 to help the citizens of Pine and Eagle valleys improve the county road from Pine to Eagle valley, and it appearing to the court that the road referred to is a very important one to the citizens of the South East part of the county and that it would be a great hardship on said citizens to do the necessary work on said road. It is therefore considered and ordered that said petition be granted and that an appropriation of \$600.00 be made, to be applied on said road and that R.M. Compton be, and he is hereby appointed to superintend the improvements on said road.
