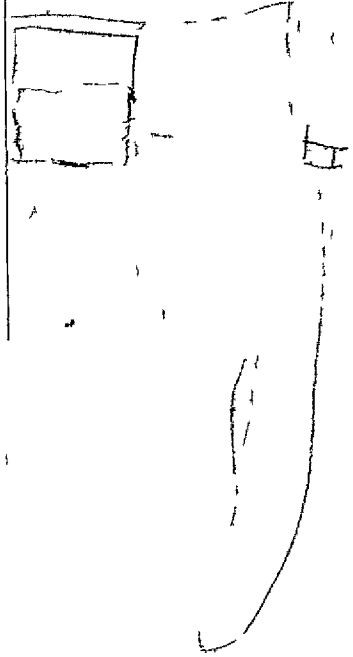

You and each and all of you, will take notice that undersigned house-holders for Union County Oregon residing in the vicinity where the hereinafter described road is proposed to be well at the next session of the County Court for Union County Oregon to wit

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

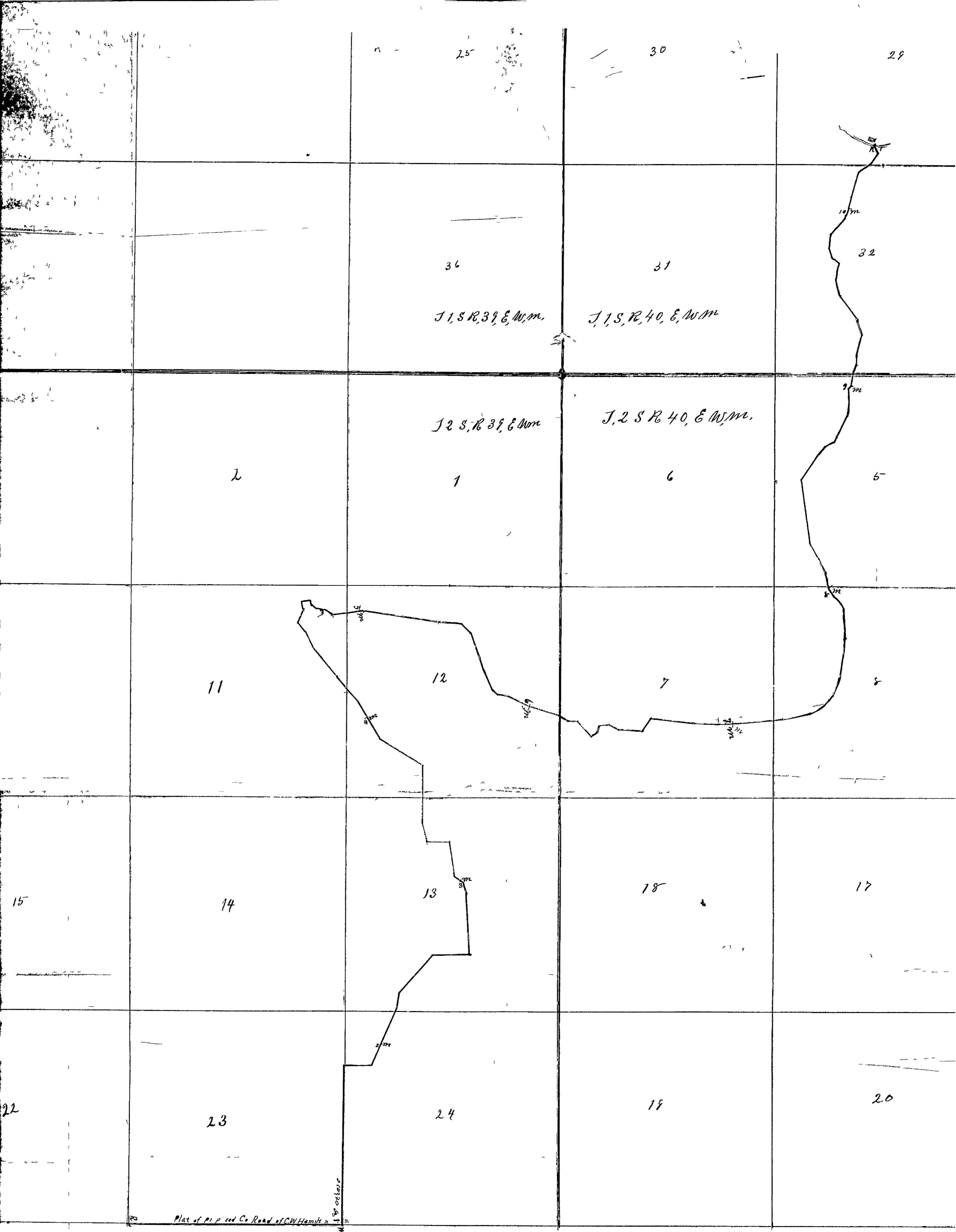
