## REPORT OF VIEWERS.



TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned viewers heretofore on the 5 day of September, 1888, appointed to view and lay out and alter the proposed County road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by G. M. Ritchey, et al, beg leave to report that on the 15 day of September, 1888, in pursuance with said appointment and order, after being duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of said appointment, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinion said proposed road should — be laid out and established as a public highway of UNION COUNTY, OREGON. That the same is practicable and would add much to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof, we therefore recommend that said proposed road be — laid out and declared a public highway of said county.

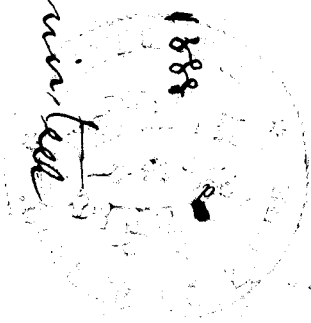

Delinquent Taxes }

This matter comes on for consideration on the matter of the Delinquent Tax List. And the court finds that there is a long list of Delinquents on the Tax List, many of whom could and should pay their taxes and if they will not pay, they should be compelled to pay, by the sheriff, who is falling far short of his sworn duty, which is greatly to the prejudice of those who pay their taxes, in returning parties delinquent time and again, and year after year, when they can and should be made to pay. These delinquents pay no interest to the county if they eventually pay the tax, while the county has to pay interest on her indebtedness. And the longer the payment of taxes is delayed the more of it is lost entirely. Now therefore the court instructs and requires the sheriff to proceed with all possible dispatch to collect all Delinquent Tax that can be collected by levy and sale of property if necessary.
