on County Road

This matter came on to be heard upon the petition of the citizens of Pine and Eagle Valleys for an appropriation of \$30000⁰⁰ to be used and applied in opening up the following described road, heretofore petitioned for, surveyed and ordered opened, to-wit:- Commencing at a Rock 65 rods West from the South East corner of Section 22 Township 9 South of Range 45 E.W.M. in Eagle Valley (Union County, Oregon) and running West up Powder River on the North side to its intersection with the Sparta Road in the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section 27 Township 8 South of Range 43 E.W.M. And G. W. Bennhoff, one of the County Commissioners who represents that part of the County particularly not being in attendance at this term of the court, It is ordered that said petition be not acted upon at this term, but be continued till the next term of this court.

In the matter of the
petition of J. B. Shea
for a Liquor License

This matter came on to be heard upon the petition of J. B. Shea for a license to sell spirituous malt and various liquors in quantities less than one quart in the Precinct of Cornucopia for the period of six months. And it appearing to the court from proof filed herein that due and legal notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given and petitioner having paid into the County Treasury the sum of Fifty Dollars being the price required by law therefor and having produced and filed the Treasurers receipt for the same and in all things else having complied with the requirements of the law herein. It is therefore considered and ordered by the court that a license issue to said J. B. Shea authorizing and empowering him to keep and sell spirituous malt and various liquors in the precinct of Cornucopia in quantities less than one quart for the period of six months from the date hereof.

Thereupon it was ordered that Court be now adjourned till tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock

This matter came on to be heard at this time on the petition of most of the citizens of Pine and Eagle valleys. Praying the Court to make an appropriation from the County funds of \$3000⁰⁰ to assist them in opening up the following described County Road:— Commencing at a Rock 65 rods West from the S.E. corner of Sec 22 T 9 S. R 45 E. N. M. in Eagle Valley Union County Oregon and running West up Powder River on the North side to its intersection with the Sparta Road in the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section 27 Township 8 South of Range 43 E. N. M. The same being the County road heretofore petitioned for by O. W. Calladay et al No 1 and running from Eagle Valley to Spring Creek. And it appearing to the Court that said road was regularly petitioned for, surveyed, laid out, and declared a public highway of Union County Oregon, and the supervisor ordered to open the same up for travel. And it further appearing to the Court that said road is of very great importance to the people of a large portion of the County and that it will have to be built through a rough and mountainous country, and that the road works in the road district where said road is situated would be totally inadequate to open up said road, and that it would take about \$3000⁰⁰ to open up said road and make it a good highway for travel. It is therefore considered adjudged and decreed by the Court that the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000⁰⁰) be appropriated out of the County funds to assist in opening up said proposed road, with the understanding that the citizens of Pine and Eagle valleys contribute by subscriptions either in work or money the additional sum of \$1000⁰⁰ to apply on said road. It is further ordered that Fred Simonis be appointed superintendent of said work.

Thereupon it was ordered that Court be now adjourned till tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock.

Whereas on the 6th day of March 1889 the County Court of Union County Oregon by order duly entered of Record in Journal of on page 521 made an order appropriating the sum of \$2000. for the improvement of a certain road petitioned for by J. H. Calladay and others No 1 situated in Eagle Valley and more particularly described in said order, and in and by said order appointed Fred Simonis Sr. as Superintendent of the said improvement and to expend said appropriation. And whereas, It appears to the Court that said Fred Simonis Sr. has failed to qualify as such Superintendent and that it is necessary that said improvement should be immediately proceeded with. It is therefore ordered by the Court that the said appointment of Fred Simonis Sr. be and the same is hereby annulled and set aside, and it is further ordered by the Court that Frank O. Lee be and he is hereby appointed as Superintendent of such work and the expending of such appropriation. And the County Clerk is hereby directed to draw warrants on the Treasurer for said amount of \$2000. in favor of said Frank O. Lee in such sums as he may call for.

by J. W. Palladay et al No 1

Whereas on the 4th day of May 1889, during the vacation of this Court it became necessary to change the Superintendent of the Improvement and expenditure of the appropriation above named, owing to the failure of Fred Simonis Sr. to qualify. And whereas the Hon. O. P. Goodall County Judge and Hon. G. W. Bennehoff County Commissioners acting conjointly did on said day cause to be made and entered of record in the Journal of this Court an order recinding the appointment of said Fred Simonis Sr. as such Superintendent and appointing Mark P. Lee in the room and place of said Simonis and directing the County Clerk to issue warrants in favor of said Lee for the amount of such appropriation, to wit \$2000.⁰⁰ And it now appearing to the Court that such action was wise and proper in the premises, Now therefore it is ordered by the Court that the action of said County Judge and Commissioners and the order made by them as aforesaid be and the same is hereby in all things approved, ratified and confirmed.
