In the Matter of a Settlement  
with G. W. Bartmess Road Sup.  
Road Dist. No. 3 for year 1888

Comes now G. W. Bartmess and presents to the Court the report of his doings as Road Supervisor of Dist. No. 3, for the year 1888. And it appearing to the Court that said report is in all things regular and just, it is here now approved by the Court. And it appearing to the Court that said supervisor is entitled to pay for 78 days at \$2<sup>00</sup> per day for said services. It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk issue to said G. W. Bartmess a warrant on the County Treasury for \$156<sup>00</sup> for said services as aforesaid.

In the Matter of  
Bridge Lumber

It appearing to the Court from the Bill now presented by G. W. Bartmess for Lumber that said G. W. Bartmess as Supervisor of Road Dist. No. 3 for the year 1888 purchased from S. P. Richardson Lumber for the use of County in Bridges on County Roads 10,130 ft for which he paid to said S. P. Richardson \$81<sup>52</sup> and that the same ought to be paid by the County. It is therefore hereby ordered that the Clerk issue a warrant on the Treasurer for said sum of \$81<sup>52</sup> in favor of said G. W. Bartmess for said lumber as aforesaid.

In the Matter of an  
Appropriation for  
the Improvement of a  
County Road

This matter came on to be heard on the petition of citizens of Eagle Valley for an appropriation to aid in the opening up of the County Road petitioned for by C. W. Calladay et al No. 2, commencing at the Big Eagle Bridge and running up Summit Creek, heretofore ordered opened and declared a public highway by this Court.

And it appearing to the Court that said Road ought to be opened up and placed in good condition for the accommodation of the traveling public. That it is of great importance to the people of Eagle Valley and the whole South Eastern part of the County, that the people in the vicinity of the Road have already expended over \$300.00 on said road, and have subscribed liberally in work and money to assist in completing the work, and by their petition appeal to the County for aid in completing the said County Road. It is therefore considered and ordered that the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) be appropriated from the County Treasury to assist in completing said road, and that W<sup>m</sup> Jones be and he is hereby appointed to superintend the expenditure of this appropriation, and that he qualify as such Superintendent and Execute a good and sufficient Undertaking in the sum of One Thousand Dollars Conditioned on the faithful performance of his duties herein, and the Clerk is instructed and ordered to issue a warrant on the Treasurer for said sum of \$500.00 in favor of said W<sup>m</sup> Jones to be used on said road work whenever he shall have qualified and given Bond as above set out.

Road Supervisor for }  
Road Dist No 30 }

It appearing to the Court that at the January Term of this Court Fred Simonis Sr was appointed Supervisor of Road Dist No 30. And that thereafter the Court appointed said Simonis to superintend the work on the Road petitioned for by J. H. Calladay et al No 1 for which appropriation was made by this Court, <sup>and called for under the act of the Legislature</sup> But that said Fred Simonis failed to qualify as said Superintendent and the Court did then appoint said Frank P. Lee to superintend said work and that said Fred Simonis has since died leaving said office of Road Supervision vacant. It is therefore ordered that Charles Howell be and he is hereby appointed Road Supervisor of Road Dist No 30 to fill said vacancy.

Thereupon it was ordered that Court be now adjourned till tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock
