most practicable route in a North Westerly direc-  
tion to the Quarter Section Stake, on the township  
line between Section thirty six (36), Township  
two South, Range 37 East of Willamette Meridians  
and Section thirty one (31), Township two  
South, Range thirty eight- East of Willamette  
Meridians, said Stake being at the South West-  
Corner of the North West Quarter of Section 31  
Twp 2, South of Range thirty eight-E. on the line  
North along the township line to the Quarter Section  
Stake at the South West Corner of the North  
West Quarter of Section 30 Township two  
South of Range 38 East of Willamette Meridians  
thence in a North westerly direction following
