honorable body to locate, lay-out
and grant a County Road
in the County and State aforesaid.

To Commence at the N. W. Corner
of the fence which now surrounds the
house of Henry Olsen about three fourths
of a mile east of La Grand, and
running in a south westerly di-
-rection about one and one half
miles, - thence in a southern di-
-rection, about one and one
half mile - thence southeasterly
about one and one half mile to
the Township line,

are in Township 3 S., R. 38,
East, and in Union County,

An Application will be made by the undersigned and others, to said County Court to locate, lay-out and grant a County Road to follow as near as practicable, and feasible the following route to wit:

Commencing at the N.W. Corner of the fence which now surrounds the house of Henry Olson about three fourths of a mile east of La Grande and running in a South westerly direction, about one and one half mile - thence in a Southern direction, about one and one half mile thence southeasterly about one and one half mile to the Township line. All of which points, and places, are in Township 3, S., R 38, E. and in Union County Oregon.

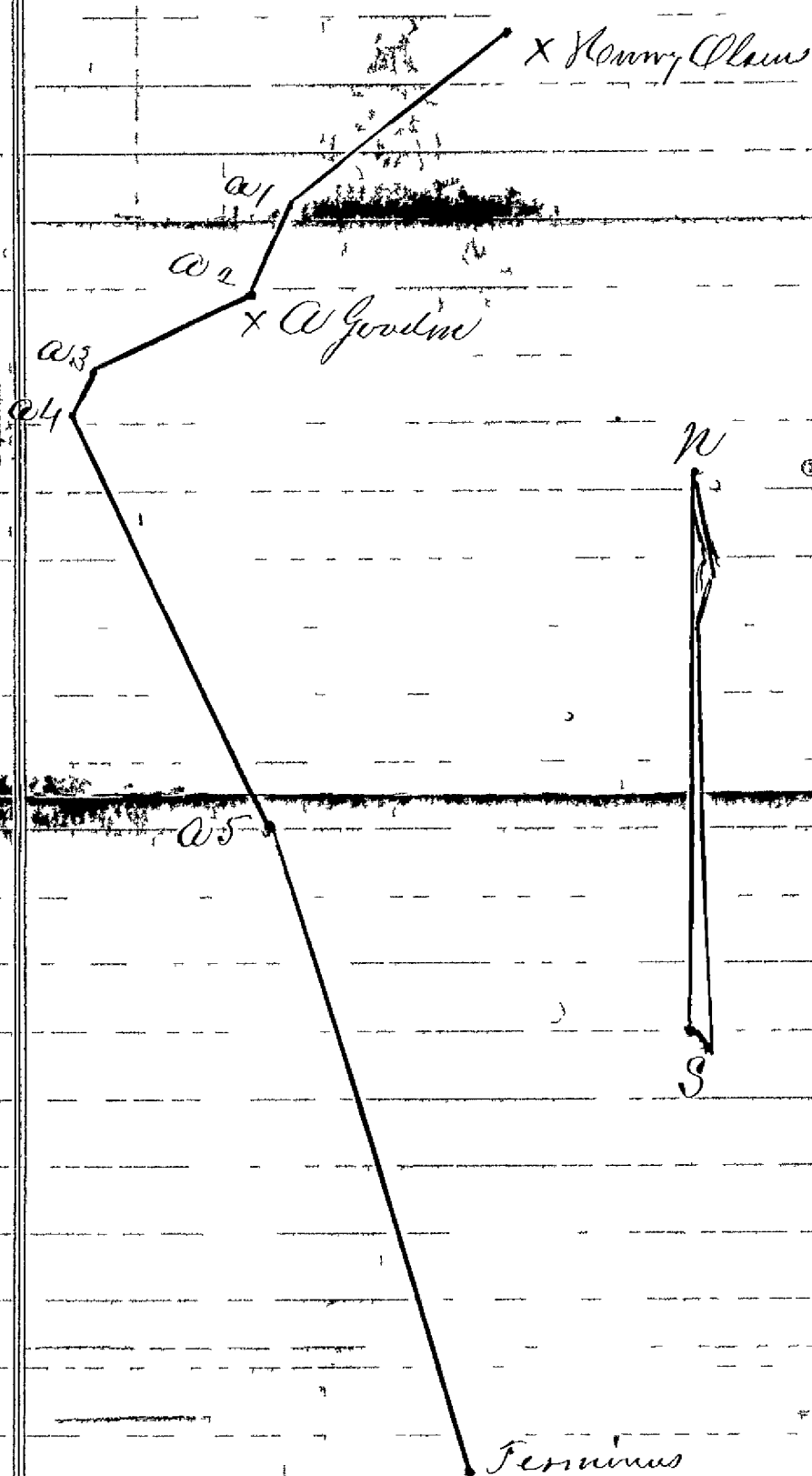

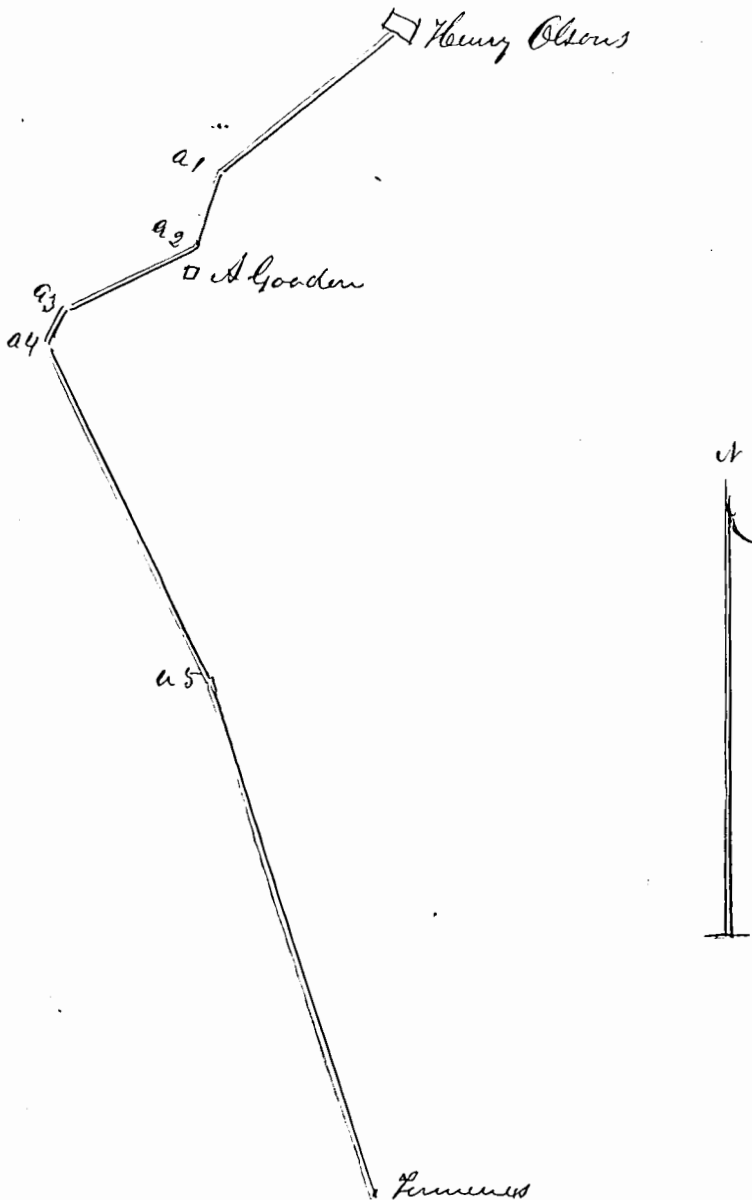
