The undersigned
householders of the State of Oregon
residing in the vicinity of the
change of the County road hereinafter set
forth ~~and located~~ ^{located}
facings the lands of Jackson Wright
in Union County Oregon do
present to the Honorable County
Court that about the 15th day
of April 1887 said Jackson
Wright residing in Lane Precinct
Union County in Road Dist
No. made a change in the
County road at then located and
travelled at the corner of his
premises to wit: of the N² W⁴
Sec. 13 Tp. 2 S R. 39 E. N. W.
That said change was made at
the point of a hill and in such
manner as to cause the road
to necessarily pass down such
hill abruptly greatly to the
inconvenience and injury of
the travelling public
that as the road was origi-
nally located the descent of said
hill was gradual and easy
that the said Jackson Wright
is the owner of the lands on

both sides of the road as change
as well as originally located
and travelled

That as we are informed and
believe said change was made
in said County road without
petition for the same or without
authority and we further say
that it is impossible to put
the road in as good condition
for the convenience of the public
over the line to which said
change was made as where
the road originally ran.

Therefore we pray your
Honorable body for an order
directing the Supervisor of
said Road Dist. No. 1 to
forthwith open the road
at said point on the
line of the old travelled
and laid out County road
for which we will ever pray

Fifth Judicial Day

Tuesday April 8th 1890In the Matter of Road
Plows and Scrapers

It appearing to the Court that the Road Districts in Union County are poorly supplied with tools necessary to work the roads to advantage. And that it is necessary to have the road Supervisors better supplied with plows and scrapers It is therefore considered and ordered that the County Judge be instructed to purchase for the County at the most reasonable terms he can six road plows and ten road scrapers for the use and benefit of the roads and road workers of the County to be distributed among the road districts where they are most needed.

In the Matter of a Change
in the County Road in Road
Dist No 7 in Union Co.

This matter came on to be heard upon the petition of W. P. Stewart M.D., Carter and eleven other citizens and householders of Union County from which it appears that on or about April 15th 1887 Jackson Wright made a change in the County road as then located and travelled at the corner of his premises, to-wit: of the N^o 7th Sec 13 T 2 R 39 E 10 M. That said change was made at the point of a hill and in such manner as to cause the road to necessarily pass down such hill abruptly greatly to the inconvenience and injury of the travelling public. That as the road was originally located the descent of said hill was gradual and easy. That the said Jackson Wright is the owner of the lands on both sides of the road as changed as well as originally located and travelled. That said change was made without petition for the same and without authority and that it is impossible to put the road in as good condition for the convenience of the public on the line to which said change was made as would the road originally run. And petitioners ask the Court to order the Supervisor of Road Dist No 7. to open up the road at said point on the line of the old travelled and laid out County road. It is therefore considered and ordered by the Court that G. G. Gray Road Supervisor of Road Dist No 7. be instructed and ordered to open up the old County road as prayed for in said petition.
