 Residence thence running in a South Easterly
 direction to the farm of G. W. Ames about
 6 miles thence in nearly the same direction
 to the crossing of Catherine Creek about 4 miles
 thence in nearly the same direction to Big
 Creek to the farm of Dunham Wrights about
 8 miles thence following the most practicable
 route to intersect the road running from
 Union to Jew City
 all of which points are in Union
 County Oregon March 31st 1871

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, and allowed then the said John Kroger shall pay all costs and expenses that may be incurred by reason of said View to said Court Otherwise to remain null and void

Now at this time was read for the second time a petition of W W Mitchell and thirty five others resident house holders residing in the vicinity and along the route of the following proposed Road praying for the location of a County Road to commence at or near the fence enclosing S J Frenchs new residence, thence running in a South easterly direction to the farm of G W Ames, thence in nearly the same direction to the crossing of Catherine Creek about 4 miles, thence in nearly the same direction to Big Creek to the farm of Durham Wright thence on the most practicable route to intersect the road running from Union to Gum City all of which points are in Union County Oregon, which petition was accompanied by a Bond duly approved and also of proof of Notices duly posted according to law, whereupon the Court appointed Frank P Dick William Makin and John Perley to meet at the house of E P Mc Daniels on the 24th day of May 1871 and J L Curtis Surveyor
