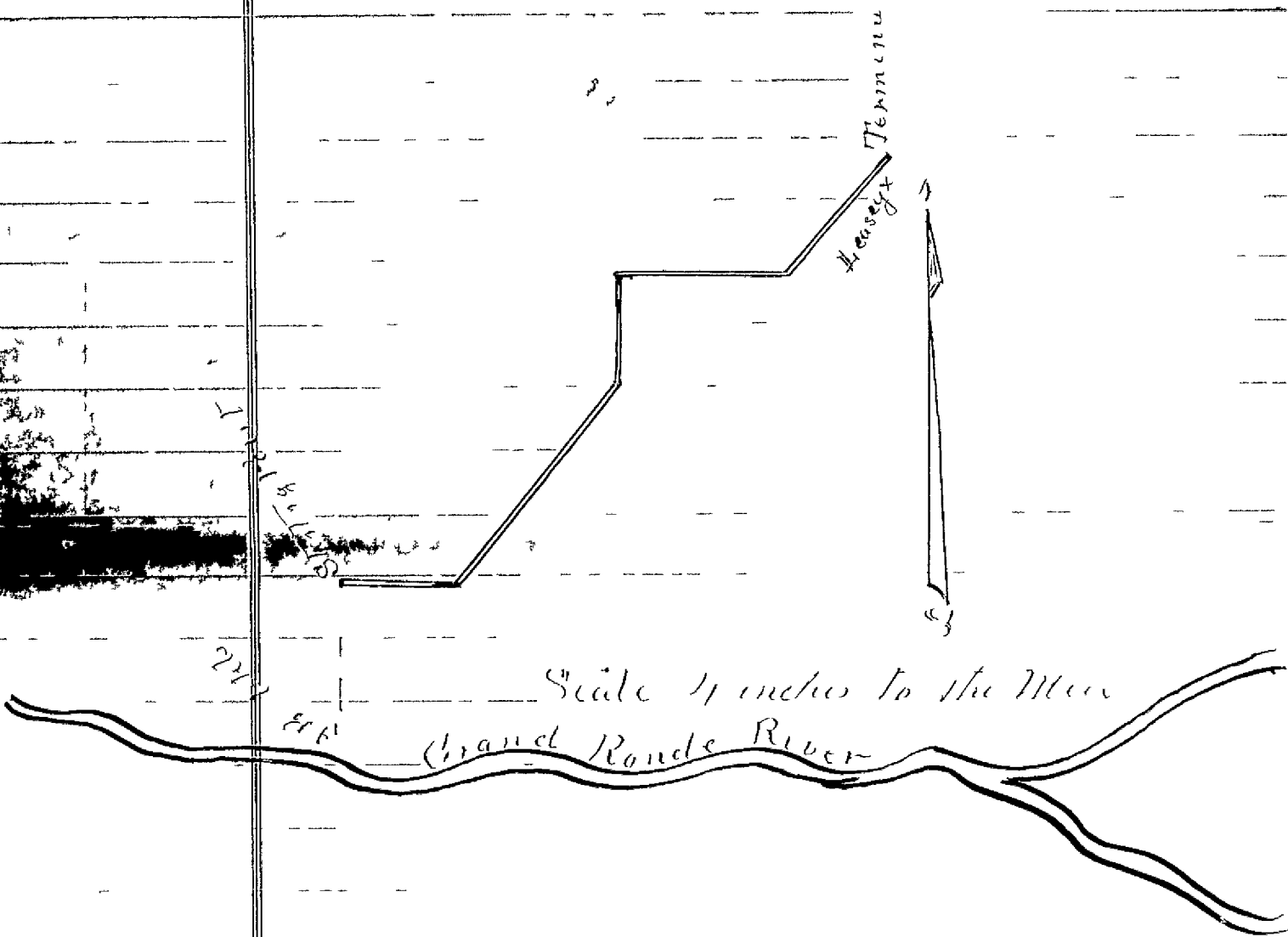

Now on this day was presented and read first time a petition for a County Road to Commence at the North End of Probsts land thence rising East to the Oadell irrigation ditch thence in a Northwesterly direction to the Section line of 28 in T2 S of R38 E thence North on said line to the Corner of the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of said Section thence East to the guide post to intersect the Summerville Road.

In the Matter of  
Liquor License

Now at this time was presented a petition of Harris and Crowder praying for a license to sell Spiritous liquors in less quantities than one quart in LaGrande Precinct for a term of Eighteen Months which petition was duly accompanied by a bond which was duly accepted and also by a notice of application for said license duly verified and by a receipt from the County Treasurer for the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars. Whereupon it was ordered by the court that a License issue to said Harris & Crowder for a term of Eighteen Months from this date to sell Spiritous Liquors in LaGrande Precinct in less quantities than one quart.

Now at this time was presented a receipt from the County Treasurer for the sum of twenty five dollars deposited by Harris & Crowder for a license to keep a Billiard table to let for hire in LaGrande Precinct for a term of Six Months from

Now at this time the petitions filed Bond in accordance of law as heretofore required for the location of a County Road to commence at the North end of Probst's lane, thence in a running East until it strikes the Crudell Hayations Dick, Thence in a Northwesterly direction to the Section line of Section 28 Range 38 East, Township Two, Thence North on said line to the corner of the North West quarter of the South West quarter of said Section Thence East, and Northwesterly to the guide post to intersect the Summerville Road in Union County Oregon. It is therefore Ordered that J. J. Crowder R. Ackley and Henry Rimhart be and they are hereby appointed Viewers with J. L. Curtis Surveyor who are to meet at Henry Rimhart's Store on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January 1872 and qualify and Report their proceedings at the next term of this Court.

Now at this time was presented Viewers Report and plat of Survey of a County Road, commencing on the County Road leading from H. Shoemaker's to Summerville at or near the South West corner of Capt. Wilson's field Thence East to the North East corner of John Van Orden's farm, Thence South to the North West corner of E. Paynes farm Thence East three miles to a point at the foot of the Mountains all of which points are in Union



In the Matter of a proposed  
County Road in Union County

Now at this time was presented a petition praying for the location of a County road, which petition was signed by more than twelve resident householders residing in the vicinity and along the line of said proposed Road, which petition was accompanied with a Bond as the law requires in favor of Union County, which Bond was approved by the Court, and also with proof of Notices having been posted more than thirty days prior to the first day of this term of Court, commencing at the County Road in Union precinct at or near the House of Thomas P Baird and running westerly One Mile, thence Northward one half Mile, (thence Northward one half) Mile, thence westerly One and one half Mile to intersect the County Road leading from Union to Salpand all of which points and places are in Union County, Oregon

It is therefore Ordered that Charles McClure, John Russell and Adam Gorge be and they are hereby appointed Viewers to view, set out and mark said proposed Road and J. L. Curtis is hereby appointed Surveyor of the same who are to meet at the House of Clark & Newhard on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1872 and report their proceedings at the May term of this Court.

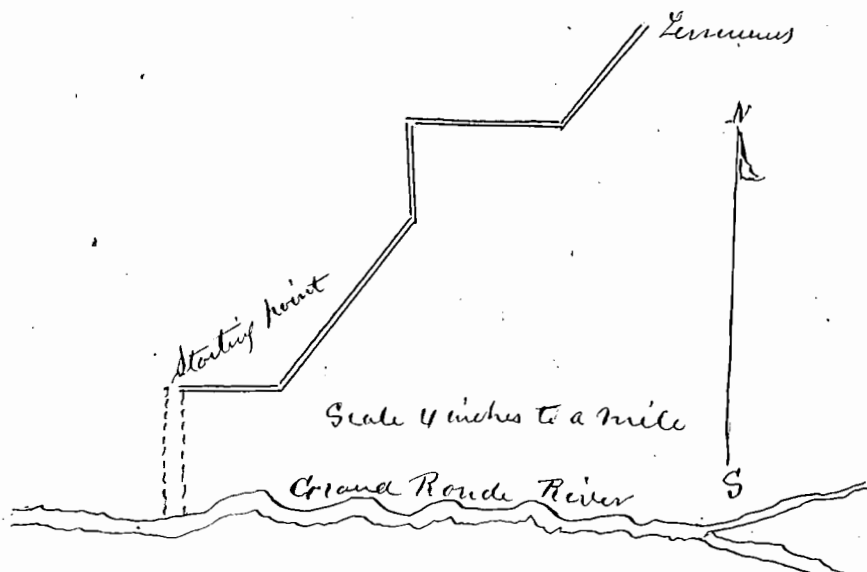
In the Matter of Viewers

Curtis County Surveyor heretofore appointed and after due Consideration by the Court it is Ordered that the report be accepted and that the Same be declared a public highway in accordance and on the line of the following plat and field notes and that the Same is Ordered opened and kept in repair by the Supervisors of Roads in Said district
