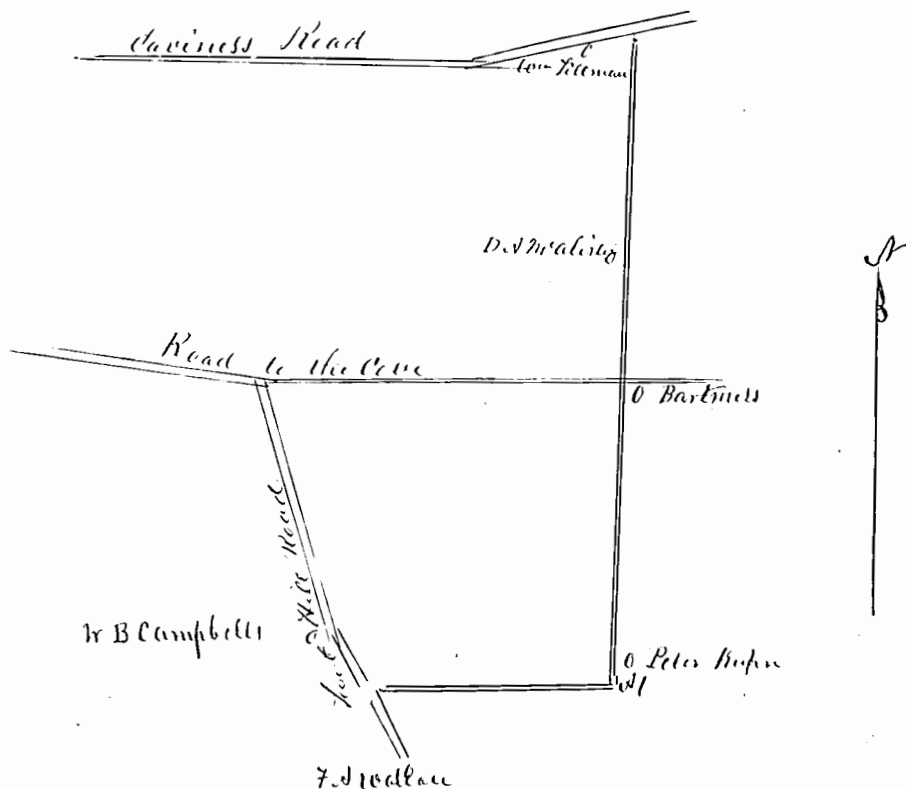

In the Matter of Petition  
for Location of County Road B

Now at this time  
petition praying for a County Road to commence  
on the County Road leading from Shoemakers  
to Summerville at or over the SW corner of Capt  
Wilson's field, thence East to the North East  
Corner of John Van Order's farm, thence South  
to the NW Corner of E Paynes farm, thence  
East three miles to a point at the foot of  
the Mountain, coming on to be read the  
second time. It is Ordered that Nelson  
Schoonover James Bartlett and Weldon A.  
Morris be and they are hereby appointed  
Viewers of said proposed road and J. L.  
Curtis Surveyor, who are to meet at the house  
of J. A. Wilson on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1871  
and report at next term of this Court.  
Court then adjourned until to-morrow at 9  
o'clock

It is therefore hereby Ordered that Philip Fitzwater be and he is hereby appointed Justice of the Peace for the precinct of Union, Union County Oregon until his successor is Elected and qualified

In the Matter of Appointment  
of Viewers on Road 3

Now at this time the petitions filed Bond in accordance of law as heretofore required for the location of a County Road to commence at the North end of Probst's lane, thence in a running East until it strikes the Crudell Hayations Dick, Thence in a Northwesterly direction to the Section line of Section 28 Range 38 East, Township Two, Thence North on said line to the corner of the North West quarter of the South West quarter of said Section Thence East, and Northwesterly to the guide post to intersect the Summerville Road in Union County Oregon. It is therefore Ordered that J. J. Crowder R. Ackley and Henry Rimhart be and they are hereby appointed Viewers with J. L. Curtis Surveyor who are to meet at Henry Rimhart's Store on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January 1872 and qualify and Report their proceedings at the next term of this Court.

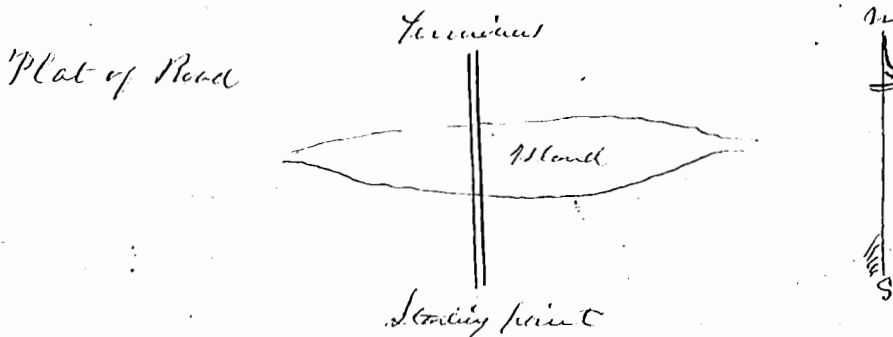

Now at this time was presented Viewers Report and plat of Survey of a County Road, commencing on the County Road leading from H. Shoemaker to Summerville at or near the South West corner of Capt. Wilsons field Thence East to the North East corner of John Van Orden's farm, Thence South to the North West corner of E. Paynes farm Thence East three miles to a point at the foot of the Mountains all of which points are in Union

and it appearing that H A Mitchell has filed Bill of Damages in the Sum of \$500. Also Fredrick Mitchell a Bill of Damages in the Sum of \$700. It is therefore Ordered, that Weldon Morris M G Israel and Benj Stanton be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, to View and assess the Damages if any the Said H A Mitchell and Fredrick Mitchell shall sustain by reason of Said Road running through their Lands, who are to meet on Monday the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1872 at the house of Weldon Morris, and qualify and Report at the next term of this Court their findings

In the Matter of location  
of County Road

Now at this time was presented Viewers Reports accompanied by plat and field notes of the Survey of a County Road commencing on the Road leading from Laland to the Cove, where said Road crosses the Range line dividing Ranges 38 and 39 East thence North on said Range line to the quarter Section corner on the west line of Section 30 Township 2 South of Range 39 East or until it intersects the Road running East & West by Mepunus' farm. It is therefore Ordered that the Report of said Viewers be granted and that the Road be and is hereby declared a public high way in accordance with the following field notes and plat of said Road.

Now on this day was  
 presented the Reviewers Report heretofore appointed  
 to view and assess the damages that Frederick  
 Mitchell and H. A. Mitchell would sustain  
 by reason of a Certain County Road running  
 through their lands if any. Commencing at the  
 SW corner of C. W. Wilsons field, thence East to the  
 NE corner of John Man Obeds farm, thence South  
 to the NW corner of E. Pappes farm, thence  
 East three miles to the foot of the Mountains  
 And it appearing to the Court that the Report  
 submitted by said Reviewers was not in accordance  
 with the law. It is therefore Ordered that the  
 Consideration of the Same be continued until  
 the May term of this Court, and that said

In the Matter of Viewers  
Report to assess Damages

Now at this time the Viewers heretofore appointed to assess damages if any that Frederick Mitchell and H. A. Mitchell would sustain by reason of a County road running through their lands which report allowed H. Mitchell the sum of \$224, and H. A. Mitchell the sum of \$112. Making in the aggregate the sum of \$336. And the Court deeming said road not of sufficient importance to the public for County to pay the damages the Court therefore refuse to establish said road unless the petitioners shall pay the expenses and damages thereof,

In the Matter of  
Viewers Report

Now at this time was presented the report of the Viewers heretofore appointed to view a road commencing near the house of T. P. Baird in Union County, Oregon and terminating on the foot Hill Road from Galbraith to Union which report stated that they met on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1872 and after being duly sworn proceeded to view and locate said road with J. L. Curtis as Surveyor, and located said road as the following field notes and plat of the Surveyor, and further that they believe the same to be of practical benefit for a highway.

It is therefore ordered that the said road as shown by the following plat and field notes of said Surveyor herein after recorded be and the same is hereby declared a public highway, and that Supervisors are hereby ordered to open and keep the same in repair as other County roads are opened and kept in repair.
